ejected by landlords from there and came to Nenagh (possibly to Tidney's Lane). He lived at White Walls
part of Nenagh and had 4 sons + 1 daughter (Mrs. Smith), William, Mike, Patrick + younger. Mrs. O'Neil, Cooney
a widow lives there now!

He also knows a bus driver on the CIE

anti-republican Con Cooney (see p. 45) whose family lived with at BENEDINE!



Plea to save historical sites

A plea for the preservation of old traditions and sites of historical interest was made yesterday by the Archbishop of Tuam, the Most Rev. Dr. Joseph Cunnane.

Speaking at the unveiling of a plaque to commemorate the foundation of Tuam 1,400 years ago he said there was a danger of old traditions being lost and ancient monuments being demolished.

Dr. Cunnane paid tribute to local historian, D. J. Murphy and John Waldron, and to a team of young boys who were helping establish a memorial park to Rory O'Connor, Ireland's last High King in Tuam. The plaque which the Archbishop unveiled was erected by the Old Tuam Society on the site of the tumulus or mound from which the town derives its name.
