

#### Possible Connections Con Ryan (Connie) of Glown



The individuals labeled Ryan 1 - Ryan 4 are simply place holders, they are not necessarily named Ryan. The labels, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, etc, indicate the degree of cousin relationship. Ellen Ryan (1852) married her 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin, Edmond Ryan, in 1878. He was the nephew of Mary Ryan (my gg-grandmother) in the far right column.

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#### **DNA Matches**

The standard setting for the segment length in the GEDmatch Autosomal 1-to-1 DNA comparison is 7 cM. In the comparison results described below that threshold has been lowered to 3 cM. Lowering the threshold increases the error of finding a common ancestor in a single comparison. However, the cousin levels of the proposed descents have already been determined from the paper records. It is the patterns and the relative sizes of the matched segments, all taken together, that are being used to determine the better fit of the two possible descents.

**Note:** It is curious that Graeme's match to the Ryan cousins were almost identical. This result wouldn't have been expected if the measurements were too far into the noise level, caused by lowering the segment length threshold.

The unexpected size of the "match" between myself and Graeme raises the possibility that his Ryan connection is closer to my Ryan line and subsequently he would be connected to Con Ryan (Connie) of Glown in the same manner that I am. If the Commanealine descent is correct there should have been a ZERO match between Graeme and myself. This second line of descend is traced out in the modified pedigree diagram in the Summary and is a reduced scale version on the next page. In the main portion of this paper the Commanealine and Glown lines will be traced out via church records, in addition to civil and census records.



About the same time there was a Conor Ryan (probably Patrick's brother) who was also residing in Commanealine, married and also having his children baptized in Doon and Castletown RC parish.

This Patrick and Mary Ryan are probably not the parents of the Bridget Ryan who married Patrick Ryan (Gerry) since there is no baptism record of this couple having a daughter named Bridget.



#### **Bridget Ryan's Parents**


From the record of Bridget Ryan's marriage to Patrick Ryan in 1870 it was determined that she was born in 1845, her father was named Patrick. She was residing in Commanealine, at the time of her marriage but that doesn't mean that she was also residing there at the time of her baptism. Therefore all the baptism's of a Bridget Ryan with a father named Patrick will be collected for some nearby parishes between Doon and Castletown and Upperchurch over the period  $1845 \pm 5$  years.







By fitting Bridget's ages: at the time of her marriage in 1870 (25); the 1901 census (57); and at the time of her death in 1908 (65), these are seen to be consistent with her being born in 1844. Her birth year in the family tree diagrams was 1845.



The civil birth records are included on the left hand side of the family tree where the church and civil records overlap. On the right hand side of the family tree mainly church baptism records are included, when the civil church records end the civil birth records are used if they are available. In some cases the baptism date precedes the birth date and in those cases the birth date is highlighted in green. Occasionally there is even a difference between the name found in the birth registration and in the baptism record. In these cases the civil birth record name is highlighted in green. Due to penalties for late registration and stubborn Irish resistance the baptism dates are probably closer to the actual birth date. For official government activities the birth registration date is taken as the official birth date.


#### Summary

#### Two Possible Descents for Graeme Reed

Item	Descent #1 - Commanealine	Descent #2 - Upperchurch
Patrick Ryan	There was a Patrick Ryan living in Commanealine in the 1840s. He was married and had several children - but none named Bridget.	There was a Patrick Ryan living in Upperchurch in the 1840s. He was married and had several children. In 1845 his daughter named Bridget was born. However, in 1850 he had a second daughter who was also named Bridget. This means that the older Bridget had died and the family reused the name. This documents Patrick - Bridget combination but this Bridget is 5 years younger than the marriage record Bridget and not residing in Commanealine.
Family Connection	Patrick Ryan of Commanealine erected a gravestone for his parents in the Upperchurch cemetery. His name appears at the top of the stone but there is no other information about him. The inscription doesn't say "erected by" and it doesn't give birth, death or age information about Patrick. All the information in the inscription is in reference to his parents. It isn't known for certain that the Patrick in the baptism records is the same person from the gravestone.	The family connection proposed for this Patrick Ryan makes him the brother of my gg-grandmother, Mary Ryan. It is known that she had 2 or 3 sisters and a brother named Jeremiah and there might have been other siblings. Nothing is known about their parents so it is possible to insert this Patrick into the family without contradicting any known facts.
Bridget Ryan	There is no baptism record for a Bridget Ryan, born in 1845, in the Doon and Castletown parish records (Commanealine).	There is a 1850 baptism record for a Bridget Ryan whose father was Patrick. However, she is 5 years younger and residing in a townland different than Commanealine.
Residence	The 1870 marriage record is the only item which connects Bridget Ryan is Commanealine.	During the time period 1850 to 1870, Bridget could have moved from Upperchurch to Commanealine.

Bridget Ryan (gg-grandmother of Graeme Reed) was married in 1870 when she was 25 years old. Her father was named Patrick and her residence at the time of her marriage was Commanealine. By fitting Bridget's ages: at the time of her marriage in 1870 (25); the 1901 census (57); and at the time of her death in 1908 (65), these are seen to be consistent with her being born in 1844. Her birth year in the family tree diagrams was 1845, which was inferred from her age in her marriage record.

The DNA comparisons of the two possible descents proposed in this paper show that the 2<sup>nd</sup> Descent (Upperchurch) gives more consistent results for the four individuals whose DNA results were compared. This can be seen in the Graeme Reed tables for the two descents (see Descent Comparisons). The 2<sup>nd</sup> descent increases the degree of the "cousinships" and therefore lowers the size of the expected segment matches with the Ryan cousins. This 2<sup>nd</sup> descent also provides an explanation of the non-zero match between Graeme and me.

I believe I am descended from Con Ryan Snrs brother, Patrick and hence Con Ryan and Mary Fogarty(referenced in PHOTO IMGP# 0317). These photo references are from 'Jeanies Pictures, 2005'.

These links are based on paper records so far. I have identified one descendant from the Ryan Connies, Tommy McGrath from Birchgrove, and he has recently sent in a DNA sample to Ancestry. I am hoping when his results come in (within next few weeks) there will be a match between him and my closer Ryan relatives. His grandfather, Patrick McGrath (1881-1963) of Turaheen, married Johanna Ryan of Birchgrove in 1919.

Aside from Tommy, I have not found other paper based descendants to test...yet! I am going over to Ireland in May and will hopefuly meet some more possible 3rd-4<sup>th</sup> cousins.

My 2 x great grandfather, Patrick Ryan (1844-1909) died in Nenagh but was, according to his obituary, brought for interment at the family burial ground at Upperchurch. This Patrick was not actually a Ryan Connie, but a Ryan Gerry (he married a Ryan Connie, daughter of Patrick mentioned above) and originally came from Mienvee/Garrycummer. So, I am wondering if his line also comes from Upperchurch Ryans, possibly this line?

I wonder if Con Ryan of Glown, or any of his descendants, ever did a DNA test? From my calculations Con Ryan would be a 3<sup>rd</sup> cousin twice removed to me, so something could show up in DNA matching. I note from the website you visited with Con's daughter, and wonder if you are still in contact with her?

My primary Gedmatch kit is ML8962265. Ive checked it against the ones I could find mentioned on your website, but no links there.

I hope this email makes some sense and is of interest.
