

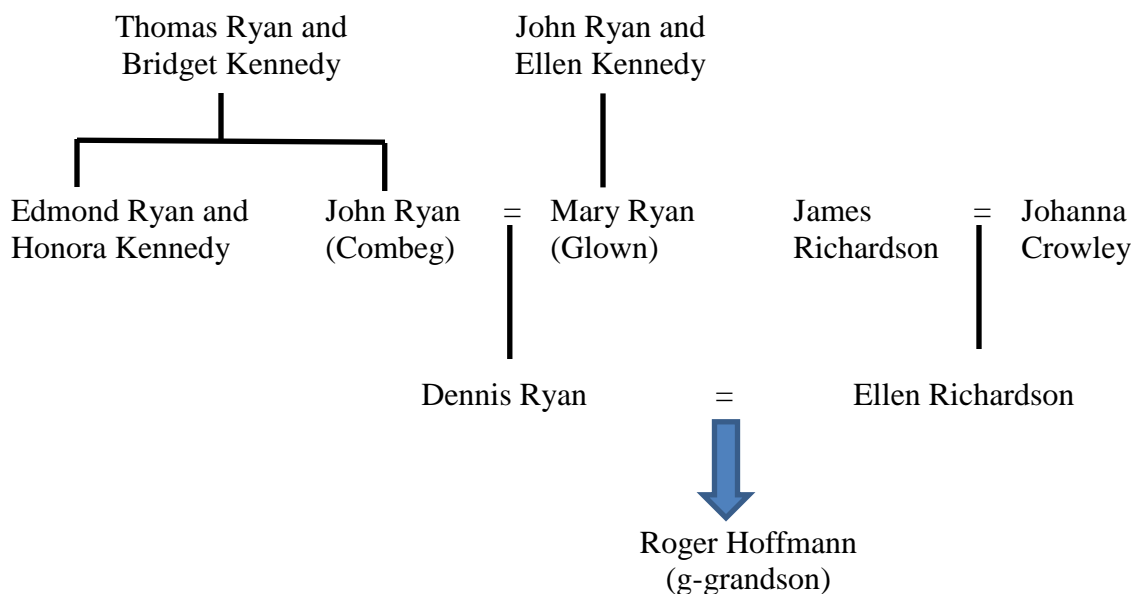
RYAN - KENNEDY OF UPPERCHURCH

The following document represents a summary of information on the descendants of Thomas Ryan and Bridget Kennedy from several sources. The bulk of the material comes from the research of Roger Hoffmann. The resulting summary found in this document is something between a pedigree (one person) and a full blown multi-generation family tree. One of the goals here is to emphasize the connections from present day going back as far as the existing data will support. These sequences of connections are meant to serve as a destination target for persons who have had their Autosomal DNA tested and are now tracking down their matches.

Over the last six months another researcher, Clare McCarthy, has been making significant progress in finding her family connections in the Upperchurch area. She established her connection to the John Ryan and Ellen Kennedy family, highlighted below. Roger then realized that his Mary Ryan was from that same family.

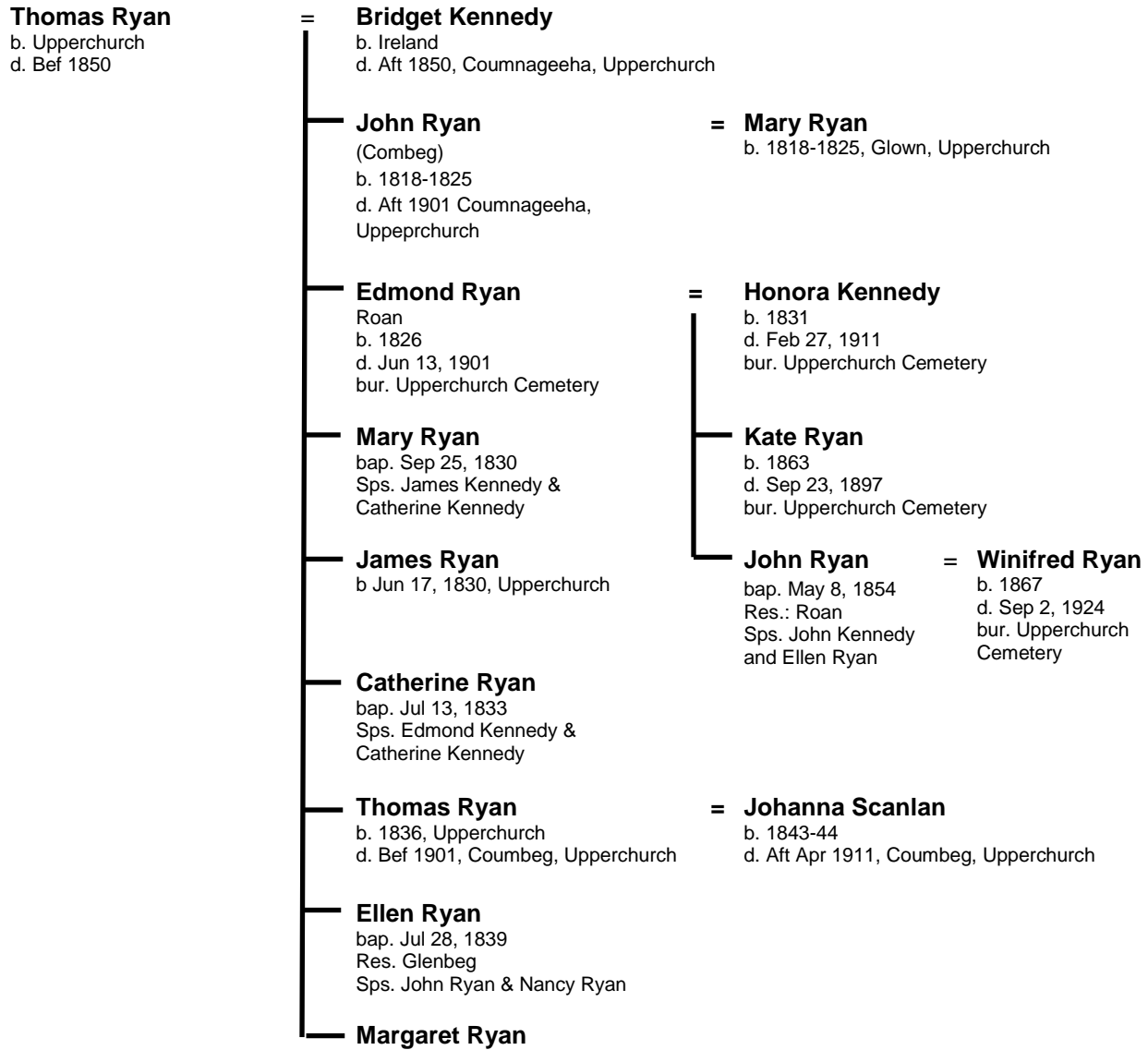
RYAN - KENNEDY FAMILY OVERVIEW

THOMAS RYAN AND BRIDGET KENNEDY

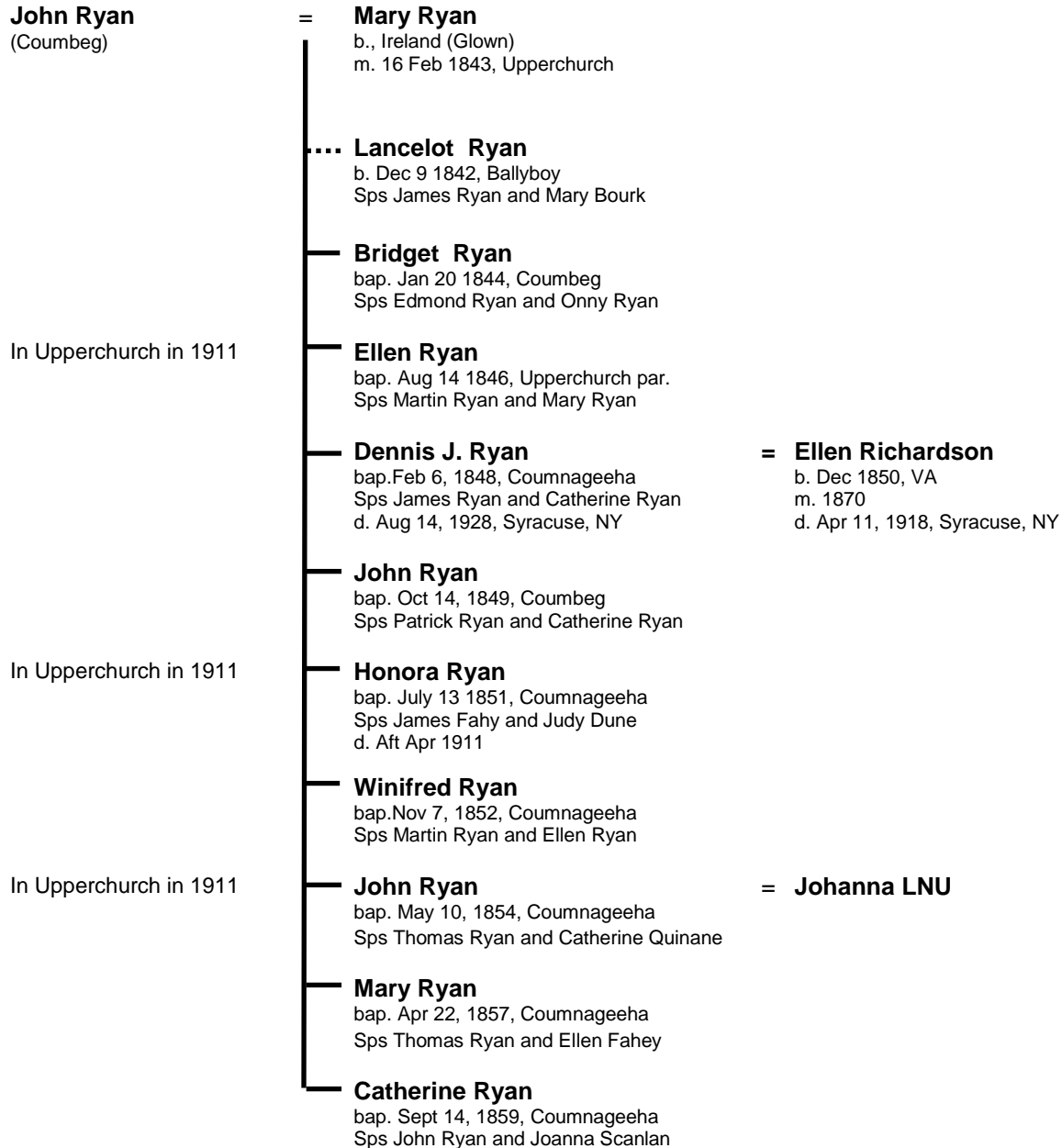


Edmond Ryan, his wife and children were found in the Upperchurch Cemetery. The relationships for Edmond's family are based mostly on the gravestone inscription, with the exception of Edmond's son John whose information is from the parish registers. The exact connection of John Ryan and his wife Winifred's connection to Edmond Ryan was initially uncertain since both were Ryans. Later it was found that Edmond and Honora had a son named John who was baptized at Upperchurch on May 8, 1854 and they had no daughter named Winifred. The children Mary, Catherine and Ellen Ryan were found in the Upperchurch & Drombane Parish Registers. The information for the remaining children came from the research materials of Roger Hoffmann.

When I gave my John Ryan/Mary Ryan family (which included Lan't) to [my Irish researcher], he stated that he felt Lan't was to a different John Ryan / Mary Ryan; a couple who married earlier and who also had a James (bap. 17/8/1837 Sp. Antony(?) Ryan and Mary Bourke) , Marg't (bap. 5/8/33, Sp.. Phil Stapleton & Marg't Ryan).

The different townland given for Lan't's parents' residence (Ballyboy) was and is a little curious, along with his birth 3 mos. prior to my Ryans' Feb. 1843 wedding, the fact that John was from Coumbeg and Mary from Glown. Though Ballyboy is not very distant from either and who knows where either was living at the particular time.

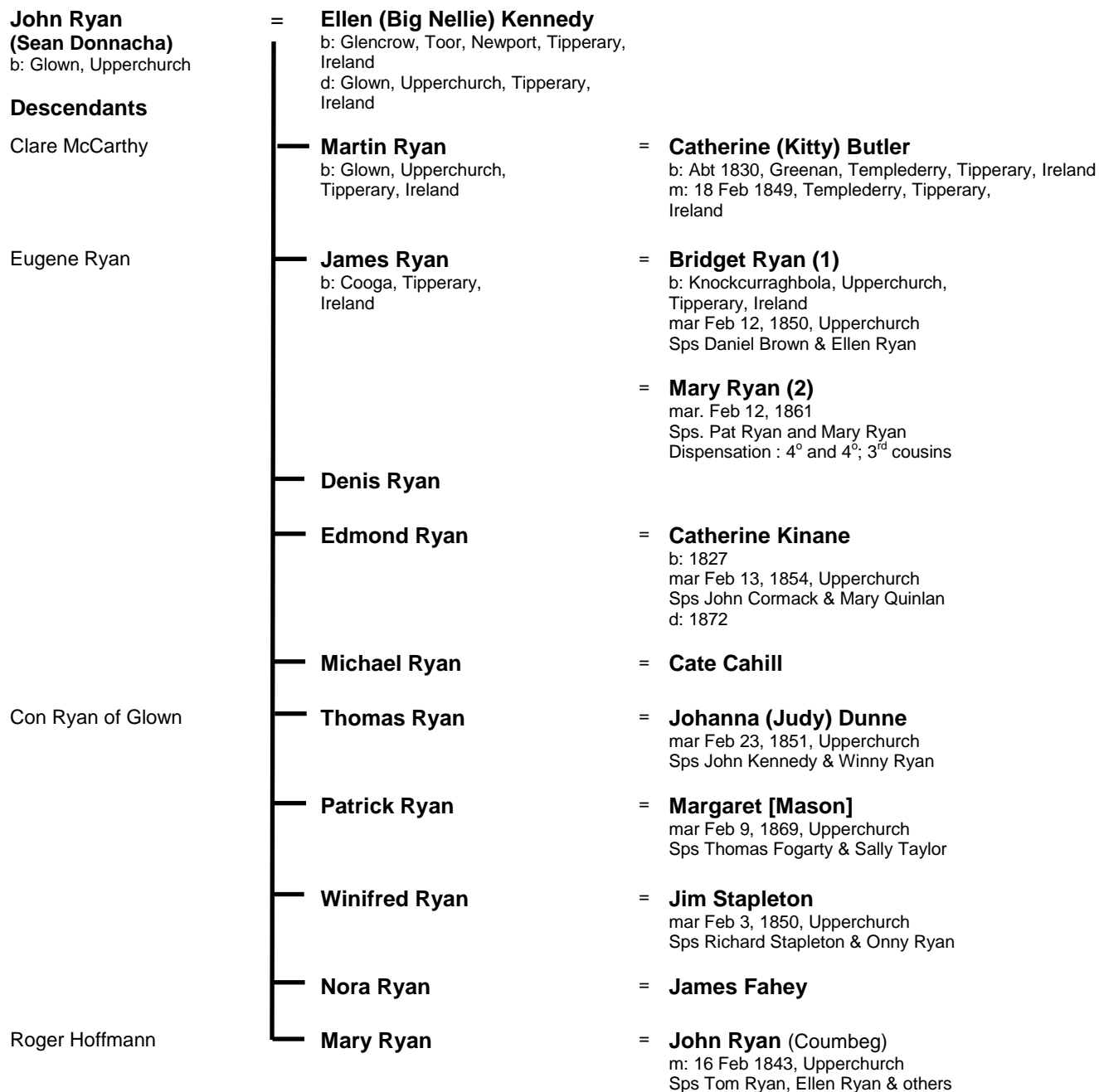
In any case, I'm leaving Lan't (loosely) attached to my John Ryan / Mary Ryan tree for the time being, with notation about Eugene's doubts.

In part that's because I'm also curious about the possible relationship if any between my family and the Laurence Ryan who was living next door in Coumnageeha / Knockcurraghbola in 1850, and as far back as 1829 at least. If my John Ryan was son of Thomas Ryan / Bridget Kennedy (as [my Irish researcher] says), and that family lived in Coumbeg, I'd like to get a better sense of movements of John Ryan & Mary Ryan.

This picture and inscription above comes from papers that were published on the McGrathSearch.com site in 2006. It all began when another Central New Yorker with Ryan and Upperchurch connections made a trip to Ireland.

“On January 3, 2006, I (Beverly Jean Muncy Bouthiller) visited the cemetery in Upperchurch village, Co. Tipperary, Ireland. While there, I photographed and made notes of several headstone inscriptions, focusing mainly on those for Ryan that had old dates. Although these may or may not be pertinent to my ancestors, I thought it would help other Ryan researchers too. I tried to be as accurate as possible. Bearing that in mind, the following is the information I recorded that day.”

John Ryan was not identified as the son of **Edmond** and **Hanora Ryan** in the inscription but he is on the right are and is buried in their plot so it is a good assumption.

The availability of the Irish Parish Registers on line allowed this fragment of a family tree to be expanded into a full tree as shown on the following page. It has been determined from the baptism records that John Ryan above is the son of Edmond Ryan and Hanora Kennedy as was supposed back in 2006.
