

## **Tony Hayes Burke's Pedigree**



William Hayes and Margaret Ryan received a dispensation for 3° and 4° consanguinity. Coolbawn is a sub-townland in Moyaliff townland in Moyaliff civil parish. Drumbane is a townland in the civil parish of Moyaliff. William Hayes: Gravestone inscription: "Died 13-Jan 1913, Aged 100 years"; Death Cert. died Jan 12, 1913, 98 yrs of age.



Erected by THOMAS HAYES of Colbawn in memory of his father Wm. HAYES who died April 3<sup>rd</sup> 1789 aged 67 yrs.
Also his mother CATHERINE HAYES alias RYAN died Nov. 11<sup>th</sup> 1814 aged 77 yrs. Also his wife ALLY HAYES alias LAMB died Nov 20<sup>th</sup> 1840 aged 67 yrs.
WILLIAM HAYES died 13 Jan 1915 aged 100 years.







The name of Bridget Cary's father was found in the record of her marriage at Kilcommon Church. It was John Cary and he was living in Cummer. There are four Cummers to choose from as shown in the table above and the two southern ones are shown in the map above. The other two are north of the village of Kilcommon (red rectangle) by the same distance that the two Cummers on the map are south of the same village. The baptism record for Bridget Cary shown above is thought to be Bridget who married Thomas Hayes in 1902. The age is about right, her father was John Cary and the residence (Foildarragh) is close to all four Cummers.
