Introduction

In 2023 two new grandchildren of Frank Lynch and Katherine Long were identified. They were the daughters of the Frank Lynch and Katherine Long's youngest child: Frank A. Lynch (1920-2012) and his wife Barbara Griffin (1926-2010). These daughters, Elizabeth "Betsey" and Mary Lynch were squeezed into the grandparents family tree at the end of this paper.

That family tree was from a document whose primary subjects were Long and McGrath families. It was decided to pursue the family of Frank Lynch, the grandparent, just to see where the trail would lead.



These are the gravestones of Sarah Lynch (1845-1915) and her husband John Lynch (1844-1892) in the Liverpool Village Cemetery in Liverpool, Onondaga County, NY. John and Sarah are the parents of Frank Lynch, the grandfather, described in the paragraph above.

After studying the census records it appears that John and Sarah arrived in the US separately and as adults. This makes finding their immigration records very difficult. Sarah's maiden name is not known and Lynch is a fairly common Irish name and for these reasons a search for their families in the Irish Parish Registers was not possible.

By 1920 Frederick Harwood had married Augusta Krafzick. It was a second marriage for Augusta but it might have been Frederick's 3rd marriage. His marriage to Margaret Lynch might have been his 2nd marriage. In the 1930 census Frederick stated that he was first married at age 25. Based on his age of 63 in the 1930 census that 1st marriage took place in about 1892, when Margaret Lynch would have only been 7 years old.

In the 1892 and 1900 census Frederick was recorded as "Single." In the 1910 census Frederick Harwood and Margaret Lynch, both single, were "Rooming" together at 310 West Willow Street in Syracuse. Therefore Frederick's "marriage" to Margaret was his first. Although her 1915 obituary referred to her as Mrs. Frederick Harwood as did her death certificate, she was buried as Margaret Lynch. At this point it is uncertain if Fred and Margaret were ever officially married.

The census records represented in the above table are those of Sarah Lynch and those members of her family who had been residing with her at the time of the census.

John Lynch, Jr. is the problem child in the census records. The age confusion found in the 1875 census can be explained by the census enumerator confusing George and John Jr. George should have been about 8 years old in 1875. With John Jr. only being 4 years old in the 1875 census that would explain why he missed the 1870 census. After that correction, John's progression from 4 in 1875 to 8 in 1880 makes sense.

Note (1) John should have shown up in the 1892 census, however if he was off on his own and he would be hard to discern among all the other John Lynchs of similar age. Note (2) John was in the service from 1898 until 1902 so he would have missed the 1900 census. John returned to Liverpool after he was discharged in 1902 and he showed up in the 1905 census.

John Lynch, Jr., died in Liverpool on November 7, 1907.

The city directories are very useful for locating individuals between the census records and for years when the census didn't record addresses. It does have its short comings in omitting wives

and also children less than 21 years of age. However it does link widows to their late husband's names which are useful for identification purposes.

Obituaries

WAS IN THE FIGHTING NINTH

John Lynch, Veteran of Wars, Passed Away at Liverpool Yesterday

“**John Lynch**, aged 36 years, died yesterday at his home at Liverpool of pneumonia, after an illness of five days.

“Mr. Lynch was a veteran of the Spanish-American war. On June 2nd, 1898, he enlisted as a volunteer and was sent to Fort McPherson, Ga. He was later transferred to Madison barracks, Sackets Harbor, and was discharged February 2nd 1899. The following day he re-enlisted in Company D, Ninth United States infantry, and on March 17th left San Francisco for the Philippine Islands. He served with the Ninth during the campaign in the Philippines and went with that regiment to China, where it served through the Boxer uprising.

“From China he went back to Manila and later to the Island of Samar. On February 20th, 1902, he received his discharge at Angel Island, Cal., and returned to his home at Liverpool, where he had lived ever since. During his service he was promoted to corporal and later to sergeant.

“Besides his mother, **Mrs. Sarah Lynch**, he is survived by five brothers, **George, James, Frank, Thomas and William Lynch**, all of Liverpool, and by two sisters, **Mrs. Edward Halloran** and **Mrs. Frederick Harwood** of this city. Funeral services will be held at the home at 9:30 o'clock to-morrow morning and at 10 o'clock at St. Joseph's church, with burial at Liverpool.”

Note: According to the above obituary **Margaret** was married to **Frederick Harwood** by 1907. However, in the 1910 census **Margaret** and **Frederick** were both single and rooming together at a boarding house at 310 West Willow Street in the City of Syracuse. In 1905 Frederick Harwood was no longer living on his father's farm in Euclid, NY. The 1905 census return for the Town of Salina is missing from the collection at Ancestry.com but it was found at Familysearch.org. Margaret Lynch, 20 years old, was living with her family but Frederick Harwood was no where to be found.

TO BE BURIED AT LIVERPOOL

Funeral of Mrs. Sarah A. Lynch Will Be Held To-morrow

“The funeral of **Mrs. Sarah A. Lynch**, widow of **John Lynch**, who died Monday night, will be held at the home of her daughter, **Mrs. Edward Halloran**, No. 229 Cortland avenue, at 9 o'clock tomorrow morning and half an hour later at St. Joseph's Church at Liverpool. Burial will be at Liverpool.

“**Mrs. Lynch** had been in ill health several weeks. She lived at Liverpool for many years and came to this city a month ago to live with her daughter. Besides her daughter she is survived by five sons, **George, James, Thomas and William Lynch** of Liverpool, and **Frank Lynch** of this city.”

“**Frederick I. Harwood**, 76, a retired druggist’s clerk, died Saturday after several months’ illness, at his home, 117 Josephine Street. Born in Euclid, he had lived in Syracuse 40 years and for 18 years was employed as a shipping clerk by the Hubbard Drug Company. He retired in 1930. Surviving are his wife **Augusta K. Harwood**; and a daughter, **Mrs. Richard L. Thompson**. Last rites will be conducted at 2 P.M. Tuesday at the Traugott, Lohman & Frazer funeral home, 516 Prospect Avenue by the Rev. Robert Baksey of St. Peter’s Lutheran Church. Burial will be in Woodlawn Cemetery.”
