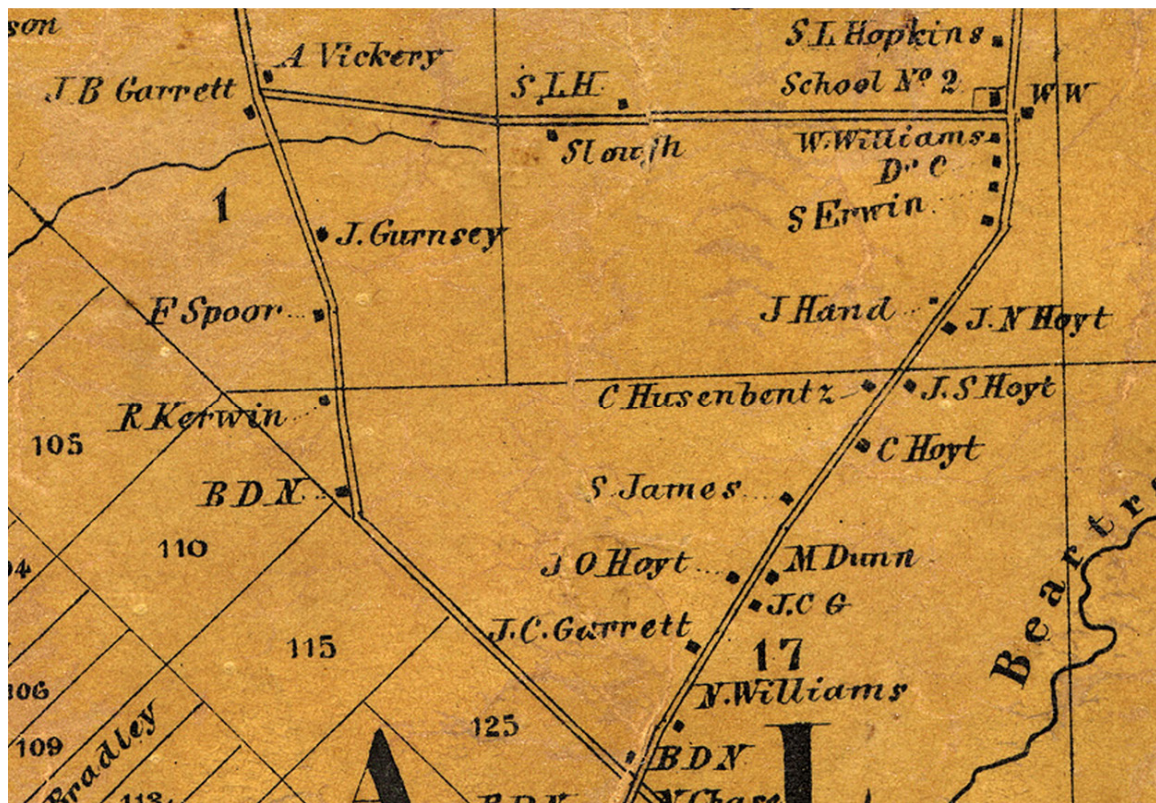
Wife Died a Few Months Ago Just Before Sixty-Five Anniversary of their Wedding

Mr. Garrett Was 87 Years Old and Had Lived in this City Since 1865 – He Was Able to Be Out on Friday – Funeral at the Home To-morrow Afternoon.

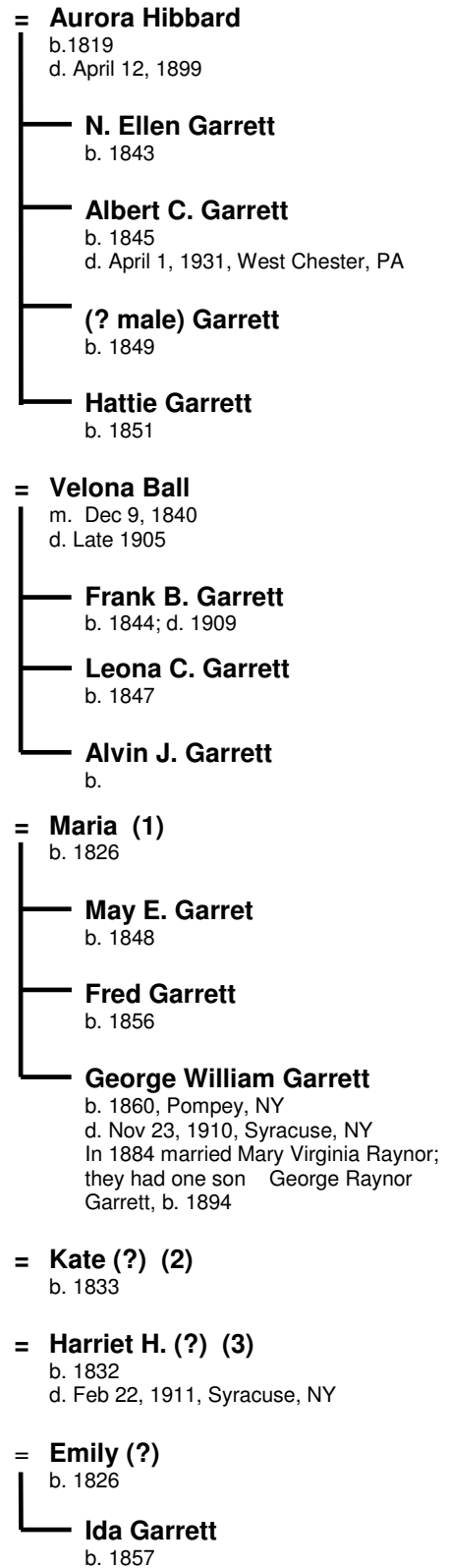
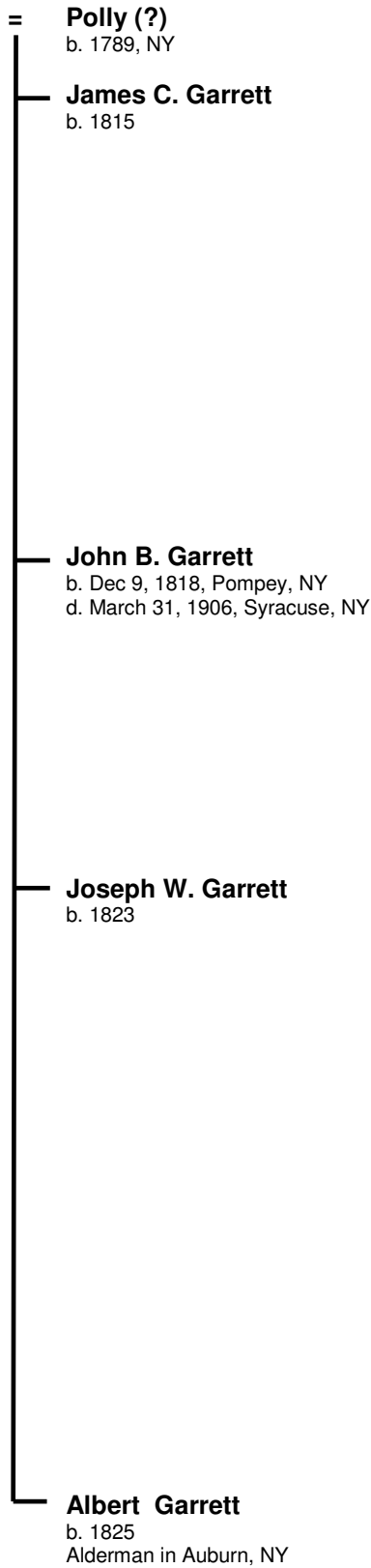
John B. Garrett was the senior member of the paper warehousing firm of J. & F.B. Garrett for 35 years.

- Origin: His family came from England and at first settled in Saratoga County, NY
- Home: 111 East Castle street
- Born: December 9, 1818, Pompey, NY
- Parents: Joseph Garrett – one of the early settlers of the town of Pompey.
- Married: Miss Velona Ball on December 9, 1840. She died in November 1905.
- Moved: From Pompey to the town of Salina in 1853 and engaged in farming
- Moved: Gave up farming in 1865 and moved into the city of Syracuse
- Business: In 1866 he joined his son Frank B. Garrett in the paper business. Retired from the paper business in 1902.
- Died: At his East Castle Street home at 6:00 PM on March 31, 1906.
- Survivors: Two sons: Frank B. Garrett and Alvin J. Garrett.

In 1853 John B. Garrett moved to Salina (7th North & Hopkins Road – GE Electronics Park) where he engaged in farming until 1865 when he went to Syracuse. In 1866 he

invested in his son's (Frank B. Garrett) paper warehouse business. In 1906 it was one of the largest concern of its kind of business "in this part of the state." J.B. Garrett retired from the paper business in 1902. John B. was the younger brother of James C. Garrett on Buckley Road in the town of Salina.
