The back end of the building is constructed of wood, so that it can be removed for enlargement at a later date. The church has steel trusses sup-porting the roof, so designed that they greatly enhance the beauty of the interior. The basement has a clear height of 18 feet, without any columns, and can be used for en-tertainments, dinners and basket ball games. Off the basement is built a kitchen, toilets, a shower and boller room, all equipped most modernly, and yet very modestly. 
