**1850 NY Onondaga Salina M432-570-290**

In this census there was a Patrick Malloy and a Walter Moley. Mary Coner and 2 small children living with the family. Ann Kirby (30); Catherine Houragan (14) – Both from Ireland. Also 5 farm laborers.

**1860**

Patrick Malloy family was not found in the E. Molloy Road area after a thorough census search. Search Salina and Syracuse 1<sup>st</sup> Ward.

**1870 NY Onondaga Salina M593-1061-639A – Res 394; Fam 394**

Richard was an invalid; the daughters had no occupations; Mary Farrell was “living with daughter.” Real Estate: \$88,000; Personal Estate: \$60,000. All children were born in NY. They came to the US prior to 1844.

**1880 NY Onondaga Salina T9-906-247B Res 126; Fam 128**

Richard and Mary are listed as being born in Ireland. That would mean they came to the US ~1850.

Thomas was a book keeper living at 128 W. Genesee St.

**1900 NY Onondaga Syracuse WD08 T623-1136-96B**

707 W. Genesee St. All single. John was a law student. Thomas (the son) was the Secretary and Treasurer of the Salt Company. Other children at school.

**1920 NY Onondaga Syracuse WD05 T625-1247-182B**

Res 215 Wilson St. All are single, none of the three had any occupation.

Even in death the spelling of the Malloy surname remains in the state of confusion. The Assumption Cemetery records listed the name as "Malloy" but the name on the monument was spelled "Molloy." All four of the Malloy family members, shown in the family tree above, were buried in Section I (letter "I"), Lot #12 of Assumption Cemetery. Lot 12 is 21' wide along the roadside and narrows to 20' on the back side. The lot is 8' deep on one side and expands to about 10' on the other side. In all, Lot 12 is about 185 sq feet in size. There are no headstones or markers for Kathie or her sister Mary to be found in Lot 12, even though the cemetery administrators are positive the two were buried there.

### 1900 NY Onondaga Salina T623-1135-205A

Res 7; Fam 8. Married 17 years; 2 children, both alive. Leger married 32 years, arrived in US in 1883.

### 1910 NY Onondaga Salina T624-1055-41B

Res 7; Fam 8. Married 28 years; 3 children, 2 alive; Stock farmer, Catherine a High School teacher; Mary – no occupation.

### 1920 NY Onondaga Salina T625-1250-173B

Mary had no occupation; Catherine was a teacher at a private school. Both daughters were single.
