

Note: The ages found in the 1870 census for Nelson and Betsey Nelson were three years younger than their ages five years earlier in the 1865 census. After checking and rechecking the numbers those were really "47." There was no overly ornate penmanship and no illegible or fading writing. The others listed close to the Phillips, in the 1870 census, were the neighbors that were expected to be found nearby – this was the correct Nelson and Betsey. Their daughter Emily's age is the continuity between the 1865 census and the 1875 census. She aged as expected. The only logical conclusion was that the census taker messed up.

NELSON PHILLIPS CHRONOLOGY

1901 – Emily M. Knowlton bought Nelson Phillips homestead for \$1000. Nelson has use of the homestead for life. Buyer takes possession 1st day of the month succeeding Nelson's death.

Friday, August 7, 1903 – Nelson Phillips died, Residence 425 Center St. Buried in the First Ward Cemetery. Nelson was 90 years of age and was "one of the oldest North Side citizens." He was survived by three daughters: Mrs. Elizabeth Kellogg; Mrs. Sybil Cooney and Mrs. Emily (Frank) Knowlton – all of Syracuse.

1908- "Nelson & Phillips" homestead for rent. 30 acres of land and buildings. Inquire 605 Third North St.

605 Third North Street

Question: Why is the 605 Third North St address connected to the Phillips homestead? In the 1900 census there were two Harrouns living at the address and they were listed as separate families. This was Residence 190 and Sarah Harroun (Family 205) and Isaac Harroun (Family 206) were both living there. Sarah was Isaac's spinster sister. To help confuse things a bit more Isaac's wife was also named Sarah – two Sarah Harrouns in the same house.

Answer: This was a two-family house. The Knowltons must have moved in sometime after July 1904 when Isaac's sister Sarah died. They were still living at 605 3rd North St. when they placed the ad in 1908. Mystery solved.

- 1900 Isaac Harroun was living at this address with his sister and his family (2nd wife). His 7 year old son was a second William Harroun (William B. Harroun).
- 1904 Sarah Harroun, sister of Isaac Harroun, died
- 1907 William Harroun at 605 North Third St. The 14 year old attended Salina School and won a kite flying contest held on Mount Olympus, south of Syracuse University.
- 1908 Nelson Phillips homestead for rent.
- 1914 William B. Harroun of 605 Third North St, marriage license to Emma L. Braun of 135 Delong.

1909-04-01 Syracuse Herald

There was an ad offering for sale a farm on the west side of Otisco Lake – 130 acres – adjoining the "Forest Home." The contact was <u>Mrs. Elizabeth Kellogg</u>, 838 Cortland Ave.

William Harroun – A Civil War Vet – Not related to Isaac above.

1904 William Harroun of 213 Center St died. Survived by a son William F. Harroun, and three daughters: Mrs. John F. Goff and Miss Nellie A. Harroun of Syracuse and Mrs. E. Smith CA., two brothers Hiram Harroun of Syracuse and David Harroun of NY and a sister Mrs. J. Hardy of Kirkville.
