

Introduction

The families described in this paper evolved from the information in the gravestone inscription below. This basic information was supplements with the church and civil records and census information.



The village of Clonoulty. The cemetery in the village is a Church of Ireland cemetery in the townland of Clonoulty Churchquarter.

"The last one on its own away from the rest of them. Erected by William MaGrath of Coolasucane in memory of his mother Johanna MaGrath Alias Quinlan died Aug st 20th 1855 aged 42 vrs. Also his father James MaGrath died Nov 27th 1867 aged 62 yrs. Said Wm McGrath died 1913 aged 77 yrs. His wife Margaret died 1909 aged 67 yrs. His sister Bridget died 1907 aged 60 yrs. James McGrath died 16th Feb 1946 aged 72. Margaret McGrath died 19th Jan 1949 aged 31. Paul McGrath died 21st Dec 1951 aged 31. William McGrath died 27th Sept 1953 aged 33. Nora McGrath died 26th Dec 1943 aged 60 interred in Kilpatrick."

This inscription is believed to be from the Church of Ireland graveyard in the townland Clonoulty Churchquarter in Clonoulty par., Co. Tipperary (In this paper this is referred to as just Clonoulty Cemetery.)



February 2, 1834 - James Magrath married Joanna Quinlan, Anacarty & Donohill RC, "...having obtained a dispensation in 4° & 4° - Grade consanguinity from the Very Rev Doctor Meagher, V. (opitulan?) in presence of Michael Quinlan, Richard Lahy and Michael Boulin. Coolaussane



January 26, 1871 - Joanna Magrath, Par. Wm Magrath and Mgt Slattery, Anacarty & Donohill RC, Res: Coolaussane, Sps. Edmond Slattery and Joanna Magrath

June 12, 1873 - James Magrath, Par. William Magrath and Margaret Slattery, Anacarty & Donohill RC, Res: Coolaussane, Sps. FN illegible Slattery and Margaret Magrath "married at Cappawhite to Nora Crowe the 12th June 1917"

These might be related to Margaret Slattery. But Margaret's baptismal record was not found in Knockavilla RC or any other parish..

August 4, 1841 - Michael Slattery, Par. Michael Slattery and Judith Connors, Knockavilla RC Res: Gurtussa, Sps. Jeremiah Connors and Bridget Connors.

July 24, 1844 - Winifred Slattery, Par, Michael Slattery and Judith Connors, Kilcommon RC Res: Gurtussa, Sps. Patrick Hogan and Catherine Hogan

March 25, 1848 - William Slattery, Par. Michael Slattery and Judith Connors, Knockavilla RC Res: Gurtussa, Sps. William Slattery and Judith Slattery




