
The Philip McGrath Family

Introduction



While compiling records for *Reaching Across the Penal Times* the records for the family of Philip McGrath and Honora Stapleton seemed to come up short. They had six children and then they all disappeared from the church and civil records for the area. No more baptisms, births, marriages or deaths for any members of the family. It was fairly certain that they had left the area as a group, but where did they go?

Earlier this month the answer to that question turned up in an email from Maureen Grattan, the g-granddaughter of Philip and Honora. Around 1880 the family immigrated to Syracuse, NY where they remained for a few years while Philip worked as a "salt boiler" in the extensive salt industry in the city. By 1887 the family had relocated to Indianapolis, IN and after that move most of the family remained in the Indianapolis area over the following decades.

In a document entitled "2011.05.11 Notes from Deette McGrath Bennett," Maureen shared some family trees and stories from her


family. In this document the names from the Bennett document were used to finish the Philip and Honora McGrath family tree. They were supplemented with a ship manifest, city directories, census records, obituaries, family related news articles and grave inscriptions.



Winifred's birth record was not found in the civil records for Thurles. The online parish registers for Upperchurch and Drombane RC, where two of her sibling's baptism records were

found end in 1876. Only John and Tim can be found in the online parish registers, although all but Winifred can be found in the civil records (irishgenealogy.ie). The baptism records for Bridget (1876), Mary (1878), Patrick (1879), and Winifred (1881) were found in the computer printout of the index to the records which ended in 1900. I only have these records because I photographed the McGrath pages in that printout during a 2000 visit to the Upperchurch parish rectory.

Finding and identifying records are two different things. Anyone can find a record for a John Ryan but the question is whether or not it's the same John Ryan that you were searching for. Civil Birth records are fairly easy to identify because each one is associated with the parents' names, a date of birth, and (usually) a residence. Civil Marriage records are the next easiest to identify because they show the names of the fathers of the couple getting married. This is in addition to the approximate or sometimes the actual ages of the couple and a geographic location. The Death records are the hardest to identify. There is the marital status of the deceased at the time of death and the age. However sometimes the death occurred at a location other than the usual residence and if death occurred in a hospital or work house then the informant will not have any connection to the deceased. Most times there will be a residence given and the age might be exaggerated (in either direction).



The columns contain the following information: Name, Age, Sex, Occupation. The names are: Philip McGrath, Honora, John, Tim, Bridget, and Winifred. The age of Philip is difficult to read but there are other records that can provide this information. Philip's occupation was "Laborer." Honora's occupation should be "Wife" but it appears to be an abbreviation of "Servant." The occupations of all the children should be "Child," but the actual entry in the manifest is illegible.

Philip McGrath's obituary identified a previously unknown relative also living in Indianapolis. This was Philip's niece Mrs. Edward Eich, with whom he was residing at the time of the 1930 census. His funeral was also held at the Eich residence.

The Sister Scenario

According to the notes from Deette McGrath Bennett (2011-05-11), Philip, Honora and four of their children "migrated to Rochester, NY where Philip had a sister who had migrated earlier." One problem with that statement is that Philip and family never made it to Rochester, instead they settled in Syracuse, NY. The family arrived at NYC on May 9, 1881 on the ship *Spain* and proceeded to Syracuse where Philip appeared in the 1881 Syracuse City Directory. At that time they were living at 43 4th South Street in the town of Geddes and Philip was probably working as a salt boiler. That street is now known as Ulster Street and it is located in a section of Syracuse long known as "Tipperary Hill" — named for the county in Ireland from whence came many of the Hill's residents.

In 1886 Philip McGrath was missing from the Syracuse directory but the following year he showed up in the Indianapolis City Directory. At that time the family was residing at 34 South Blackford and Philip was listed as a laborer. Philip appeared in all the directories up to 1900 when his trail could be picked up by the Federal Census. In 1900 Philip and Honora and eight of their children were living at 118 Senate Avenue. They moved about a half dozen times around Indianapolis over the years with Philip going from laborer to fireman and finally to stoker. These were occupations related to a gas company which burned coal to produce the gas that would light the houses of Indianapolis.

Sometimes relatives will move in with other families and at census time that gives a glimpse into the relationship of the relatives to the head of the family. This wasn't the case with Philip McGrath until the 1930 census when he was found living with his niece Mary Eich and her family at 102 N. State St. He was still residing there when he died in 1932 and his funeral was held at his niece's residence. The 1930 census described Philip's relationship to Mary's husband Edward as "uncle-in-law."

Mary Hart Eich passed away on February 27, 1954 in Indianapolis and the inscription on her gravestone revealed her maiden name as Hart, while her appearance in the 1930 census showed that she was born in Ohio in 1866 to Irish born parents. Since her maiden name was Hart it was her mother who was the McGrath and Philip would have been her brother. Mary's parents would have had to be in Ohio by 1865 at the latest and if her mother was 20 at the time of Mary's birth then her mother would have been born in about 1846, which would be compatible with being Philip's (born 1845) sister. Still problematic is the fact that Ohio is quite a ways from Rochester and Mary Hart's parents were in Ohio some 16 years before Philip and family left Ireland — this was definitely "earlier."

Upon checking and rechecking Philip McGrath's siblings in the parish registers and civil records, they are all accounted for and none had migrated to the US. Perhaps Mary Hart Eich came from the Stapleton side of the family — Philip would still be her uncle and she would still be his niece, however the sister would be that of his wife, Honora Stapleton, and not his. That wil have to a search for another day.

A search was made for the marriage of Mary Hart Eich's parents in Ireland. Of course, her parents could have equally as well have been married in the US. Shown below are the only two McGrath-Hart marriages that could be found in the Irish Parish Registers. The Drom and Inch marriage was the closest to Upperchurch parish, however the 1827 year of the marriage casts doubt on these being Mary's parents. Assuming that her parents married at age 20 they would have been 59 years old at the time of Mary's birth in 1866. In addition, further research in the Irish records might show that this John and Margaret Hart never left Ireland.



McGrath is believed to have been caught in the whirl pool caused by the intake pipe of the West Washington street power house of the Indianapolis Street Railway Company for he was whirled around several times in the whirlpool, according to witnesses, and although a strong swimmer, was powerless to escape.

McGrath, who had been married only a few months, was supposed to be in New Orleans,

She said her nephew was married Feb. 2 and went to New Orleans on a honeymoon trip.

While at New Orleans he lost his railroad passes for himself and his wife. McGrath had been employed as a railroad man by the

La., with his bride, who is in a hospital there. He was identified by a book found in his clothing and the body later was identified by relatives.

SCENE OF DROWNINGS IN 18 YEARS At the place where McGrath lost his life seven persons have drowned in eighteen years. The Nagley Gravel Company had complied with the orders of Dr. Paul Robinson, coroner, and has posted a number of signs on the bank giving a warning, "Danger, deep hole, keep out." These have not been heeded by swimmers, who have constructed a diving board and have frequented the place in great numbers recently.

McGrath during the war served in the marine corps and was a drill master at Paris Island. In spite of his age he became a sergeant.

Big, powerful and known as a good swimmer he stripped off on the bank of White River this morning plunged in and swam across the river to the flood wall. He turned and started to swim back, but sank after being whirled around several times. At first it was thought he had been taken with cramps, but later, swimmers familiar with the river, said he had been caught in the whirlpool caused by the intake pipe.

FIND POSTCARD ADDRESSED TO WIFE

While Sergeant Burk of the police department searched the clothing left on the bank to find some paper that might identify the man for whose body other police officers were dragging, he drew forth an unmailed postcard addressed to Mrs. P. E. McGrath, Charity Hospital, Ward 63, New Orleans, La.

The card read: "Dear Wife — Arrived home at 6:15 p.m. Sunday evening.

Union Railroad in this city. He, however, wrote his uncle that he did not want them to send him money but that he would work and earn enough to bring himself and his wife back to Indianapolis. The "mother" referred to in the postcard was his wife's mother, Mrs. John Linder, who lives at Kennington and Midway streets.

LIVED WITH AUNT SINCE WAS 14

"Paul's mother died when he was 14," Mrs. Billerman said. "He had made his home with me since that time and I loved him like I would my own son."

Herman Billerman, the uncle, was about to leave the city on business when the news of his nephew's death reached him. Tim McGrath, another uncle, who lives at the Billerman home, and Phil McGrath, also an uncle, 451 North Walcot street, hurried to the river where Paul had been drowned.

After a half hour's dragging, Motor policemen Wilkerson and Landers found the body in the deep water in the center of the river, twenty-five yards down stream from the diving board.

M. H. Kane, an employee of the gravel company, was in the office at Hanson avenue, near the east bank of White River, at 9:15 a.m., when four little boys came in and told him a man had been drowned. Kane went to the river bank, but could not see any one. He found some clothing, however, and took it back to the office. Then he telephoned the police. The four boys who witnessed the drowning were: Herman Anderson, 9, 415 Patterson street; Floyd Moon, 12, 402 Minerva street; Earl Von Master, 12, 242 Cumberland avenue; and Charles Hasse, 10, 366 Beauty avenue.

McGrath's relatives, with the exception of his mother-in-law, did not know he was in Indianapolis until they learned of his death.





Timothy Stapleton's parents were Thomas Stapleton and


