# **Descendants of Francis Gray and Anna McGraw**

### Introduction

Michael McGrath and his brother John came to the U.S. with their mother, Mary Ryan McGrath, on board the British Queen that landed at New York City on November 7, 1850. They were rejoining their father, Edmond McGrath, who had arrived in the U.S. two years earlier on the New Hampshire that landed at New York City on November 29, 1948. Edmond had been farming in the southeastern corner of the town of Fabius in Onondaga Co., NY. Also in Fabius, perhaps on the same farm, was Edmond's brother Lanty (Alanson). Lanty's family came to the U.S. on the British Queen with Edmond's family. Edmond and Lanty's father, Michael McGrath, and their siblings Thomas, and Margaret came to the U.S in about 1852. Michael, Thomas, and his wife, the former Catherine Gleeson, were living on a farm on in the northern portion of the town of Pompey at the time of the 1855 census. By that time Margaret had married Richard Long and was living nearby.

According to family lore a tornado had wrecked Edmond's farm in southeastern Fabius at some time prior to 1855. In the census of that year Lanty was living in the village of Fabius with no farm land, although he owned farm animals, and Edmond owned land on Morgan Hill in the town of Truxton (later part of the town of Cuyler). Later Lanty moved to Arab Hill in what is now Highland Forest Park and then by 1860 he and his family had settled in Clifton Springs, Ontario Co., NY.

Sometime prior to 1860 the patriarch of the family, Michael McGrath, passed away and he is thought to have been buried in old St. Mary's Cemetery on Renwick Ave., in the city of Syracuse. Edmond's sibling, Thomas and his wife, the former Catherine Gleeson, along with 12 other individuals from the Upperchurch area of Ireland migrated to Maple Ridge in the town of Martinsburgh in Lewis Co., NY around 1858-9. Among the dozen was Thomas' sister Margaret who had married Richard Long at St. Mary's in Syracuse. Richard was a neighbor from back in Ireland. Thomas stayed in Maple Ridge but Margaret and Richard returned to Pompey in a few years and they settled in a farm on the same road where Michael and Thomas had been living in 1855. The Longs are still living on that road and it is now named Frank Long Road after one of Margaret and Richard's descendants.

Edmond's son John joined the army and participated in the Civil War. Upon his return to Morgan Hill he went to work on the Gleeson farm on the northern end of Morgan Hill. His parents and his brother remained on the family farm further down the road on Morgan Hill. In 1867, Edmond and his sons bought a 225-acre farm in the northwestern corner of the town of Truxton on Kettlebail Road. Living just up the road from the McGraw family, on Morgan Hill, was the John Comerford family. In 1870 John McGraw married their daughter Ellen and they started their family on Kettlebail Road. After the Panic of 1873, financial ruin spread across the

farms of central New York. In the summer of 1874 the McGraw family lost their farm to foreclosure and the family spread out. Michael, who was still single, landed on the Miles farm in the southwestern corner of the town of Fabius. John and his family, along with his parents bought the former 1-1/2 acre Kent farm on Shackham Road in the northeastern corner of the town of Truxton. By 1880 John and his family had left his parents at the Shackham Road farm and moved to a farm on the eastern side of the North Road out of Truxton. Their neighbor was his wife Ellen's brother, John Comerford.

Despite the uncertainties caused by the foreclosure, John and Ellen's family continued to grow. Mary (1871) and John J. (1873) had been born on Kettlebail Road. Anna (1876), and probably Patrick (1878), and Margaret (1879) were born on Shackham Road. James (1881) and Helen "Nellie" (1883) were born on the North Road.

The late summer of 1883 had an epic tragedy in store for John McGraw and his family. Within a month of having given birth to their eighth child (Nellie), Ellen died (Aug 29<sup>th</sup>) from complications due to childbirth. Over the course of the next month John lost three of his children to typhoid, thought to be due to contaminated well water: Patrick (Sept 7<sup>th</sup>), Mary (Sept 12<sup>th</sup>), and Catherine (Sept 28<sup>th</sup>). At the urging of relatives John moved the remainder of his family into the village of Truxton where they would be able to help with the children. The exact disposition of the children is not certain but it is known that John J. moved across the street to the Goddard Hotel where Mary Goddard took him under her wing. Young Nellie was supposedly raised by John's brother Michael.

Back in 1880, John had accompanied his brother Michael to Albany (probably by train) to meet two young single ladies, named Alice and Mary Rooney, who were just arriving from Ireland. Who sent them to Albany has always been a family mystery. In 1881 Michael married Alice Rooney and soon thereafter moved in with his parents on Shackham Road. In 1890, some seven years after his family's tragedy, John married Mary Rooney at St. Patrick's church in the village of Truxton, with his daughter Anna serving as witness. John had been living on a 6-acre farm on the West Road (Tully-Truton Road) which he later purchased from John O'Connor. On July 22, 1891 Mary gave birth to a daughter named Mary Alice — nine days later the baby died on August 1<sup>st</sup>. By the time of the 1892 census the couple had split up and left the farm on the West Road. In the census Mary was living in Truxton with the Parker family, under her maiden name of Rooney. At this same time John was also living in Truxton, with the Michael O'Brien family where Michael's wife, a Comerford, was John's sister-in-law.

John McGraw had only two grandchildren whereas by contrast his brother, Michael, had 33 grandchildren. Mary, Catherine and Patrick had died young. James never married. Margaret and Nellie both married but had no children. While John J. married twice no children resulted from either marriage. Anna McGraw (married Francis Gray) was the only sibling to have any children. We knew that Francis and Anna had two children: William (1897) and Bertha (1899) but that was where the trail had ended.

Eventually my curiosity got the better of me and I went searching for the descendants of Francis Gray and Anna McGraw through the census records.

Francis Gray was born in CT in about 1873. His parents had both been born in Ireland. He was married to Anna McGraw in 1895. The family wasn't found in the 1900 census.

In 1910 the family was living on the Main Road in New Canaan, Fairfield Co., CT and Francis' occupation was that of a farmer. They only had two children during their 14 years of marriage and both of them were living at home with their parents in 1910. William F. (13), and Bertha (11), were both attending school.

By the time of the 1920 census the family was still living together in New Canaan but they had moved off the farm. They were living with the Edson smith family at 91 Forest Street. Francis was employed as a chauffeur, driving a taxi. Both of his children: William F. (23) and Bertha M. (21) were employed as clerks in a grocery store. His wife Anna (44) was listed as having no occupation but of course she was keeping house for the family.

At the time of the 1930 census Francis Gray (or Grey) could not be found in the census records. Neither Anna nor her daughter Bertha could be found. There was a William F. Gray (34) living on Hillside Ave. in New Canaan Borough, Fairfield, CT, in the 1930 census. He was renting his home for \$22 per month and the family had a radio set. His wife Mary J. (34) had been born in Ireland in 1896 of Irish parents. She had come to the US in 1912 and had been naturalized. William was still employed as a clerk in a grocery store. He and Mary had four (4) children. There were 3 sons and 1 daughter: John (9), James D. (7), Edward (8), and Anna May (4). William was a veteran of WWI. From the location of the births of their children it appears that William and Mary had lived in New York for a while: about 1922-1925.


Eventually the census records ran out and the search once again came to an end — for a while. After about 10 years the search began again and with the help of the online city directories and the Find-a-Grave website the living descendants of Francis and Anna Gray were finally found.






