Counting rules

- 1. Individuals older than 16 are considered adults, and old to enough to decide on their own destination. They count as an arrival.
- 2. Single adult children traveling with parents are counted as separate arrivals.
- 3. Brothers and sisters (16 and older) traveling together are counted as separate arrivals.
- 4. Husband and wife, or wife following her husband, are counted as a single arrival.
- 5. Underage children traveling with family or relatives are not counted as separate arrivals.
