The Tarpy Families of Martinsburg, NY

Introduction

In the beginning there was just James Tarpy and his newly wed bride, Ellen Gleason, who together had followed a number of other Pompey residents to Maple Ridge in 1860. As the effort to sort out the various Maple Ridge families and the possible connections among them proceeded, the number of Tarpy families began to multiply. The following table is useful in sorting out the various families and on the following pages more details will be presented on the different families.

The James Tarpy Family

The first record of James Tarpy and Ellen Gleeson was their marriage record of January 22, 1860. There is a record of James arriving from Ireland in 1851 (1900 census). He didn't show up in the 1855 census. A record of Ellen's immigration information might have been found. There was an Ellen Gleason in the 1855 census for Pompey, Onondaga Co.: she had been in Pompey for 3 years.

There was a <u>John</u> Tarpy who was a sponsor at the baptism of Richard Long and Margaret McGrath's son Michael on August 1, 1858. However, any connection to James is uncertain. There are three additional things that make this couple interesting: Ellen was a Gleeson, they both migrated to Maple Ridge right after their marriage. They settled next to Thomas McGrath, Margaret McGrath Long's brother and Catherine Gleeson's husband and across the road from Patrick Gleeson, Catherine's brother.

The Gleason family from Moyaliff is known to consist of Margaret Gleason Ryan (b. 1810), Patrick Gleason (b. 1819-20), and Catherine Gleason McGrath (b. 1823). Ellen Gleason (b. 1827) might have been a member of that family which would explain why she originally came to the Pompey area and subsequently followed the Moyaliff connected individuals to Maple Ridge and settled among them.

Margaret Gleason Ryan's daughter Ellen was baptized in Upperchurch on April 7, 1838 and the sponsors were Edmond Ryan and Ellen Gleason. Ellen Gleason Tarpy would have been 11 years old in 1838, but this might be her. At that time the sponsors were not viewed as "god parents" who would oversee the religious upbringing of the child in case of the parents' death. It was more of an honor and grandparents sometimes appeared as baptism sponsors.

Note: James was only survived by his wife, which might indicate that their daughter Mary was already deceased. No obituaries or graves in Maple Ridge Cemetery were found for James and Ellen's children John and Mary. Ironically, in the 1900 census, Ellen claimed that she never gave birth to any children. By using the ages of James and Ellen found in the above table their birth years can be estimated: James, b. 1820; Ellen, b. 1827.



The spelling of James Tarpy's surname in various records underwent slight variations over the years. The initial "a" or "o" in the name is the major variation. The presence of an "e" before the final "y" is just a minor variation which doesn't affect the pronunciation of the surname. On the next page an analysis of the locations of the Tarpy variations in Ireland will be conducted. It is hoped that this might shed some light on James Tarpy's point of origin.

1875 Map



This map shows a portion of Maple Ridge near the border of the Town of Highmarket. In Lot #107, the road heading east is now named Graves Road. The road that it "tees" into in Lot #107 is now named Toole Road and it no longer continues to the south. In 1860 and 1865 Patrick Gleeson, brother of Catherine Gleeson McGrath and Margaret Gleeson Ryan, was living on the west side of the road, just south of James Tarpy. Patrick Gleason was here in 1855 and he was joined by his sister Catherine Gleason McGrath in late 1858 and Ellen Gleason Tarpy in early 1860. A case will be made to show that this close proximity wasn't just a coincidence. It will be shown that Ellen could be the youngest member of this Gleason family from Moyaliff.

This is essentially the same information found in the Dunton List with the exception of a couple different spellings. Old inscriptions on weathered stones are hard to read. It isn't believed that James and John were related. No obit could be found for John Tarpy. In 1865 John and Ellen had a 4-year-old son named John and he was gone by the time of the 1870 census. Strangely he wasn't found in the Maple Ridge Cemetery.

The Journal and Republican, Lowville, NY

September 24, 1903

James Tarpy, who has been confined to the house for three years with rheumatism, suffering a good deal attimes, died last Friday with a stroke of paralysis. Mr. Tarpy was one of the old settlers of our town, living five miles west of this village, and was very much esteemed for his uprightness of daily life by all who knew him. His funeral was attended at St. Peter's church last Sunday at 3 P. M., and interment was made in the cemetery near the church. He was aged 85 years and is survived by his widow.

March 17, 1909

Mrs. Laura Puffer, 79, Lowville died Wednesday.
Mrs. Ellen Tarpey, Martinsburg, died Wednesday, aged 87.

James Tarpy's point of origin in Ireland has not been determined. In the town of Martinsburg there were a couple other Tarpy families from Co. Mayo, however there is no evidence that James is related to them. In about 1860 James appeared in the town of Pompey, Onondaga County and married an Ellen Gleason in 1860. Almost immediately after their marriage the couple took part in the Maple Ridge Migration which saw approximately individual move from Pompey to Maple Ridge, Martinsburg, in Lewis County. Although Ellen Gleason's point of origin in Ireland has not been determined it is thought that there was a Gleason connection that drew the couple to Maple Ridge.

James Tarpy's Possible Origin in Ireland

Since James Tarpy had settled in Pompey among a large number of immigrants who had come from the Upperchurch area it was decided to look for his baptism record in that area. Since James was born in about 1820 there would NOT be a record for him in Upperchurch (records began 1829) or Holycross (records began 1835) but there might be one in Thurles (records began 1800). The results of that search are shown below. This allowed for the identification of several possible Tarpy families but none of them had a child named James.



Extra Tarpy Materials



This Ellen Tarpey is the former Ellen Gleason, the widow of James Tarpy and the mother of Mary. She might have been living at the home of William Tarpey but William was not the husband of Ellen' daughter Mary.

There was no such William Tarpey with a wife Mary found in the Martinsburg 1905 or 1910 census. There was no Ellen Tarpey found in Martinsburg in the 1905 census (the census was missing). Perhaps Ellen's daughter's married name is not Tarpey. Searched the 1905 and 1910 census for Mary + any surname with birth year: 1862 ± 5 yrs. with spouse first name: W* (Exact); Area: Lewis Co. Result: no suitable persons were found. The one positive item that can be taken away from this obit is that Ellen's daughter had gotten married at some point prior to 1909 and that was why she could not be found by searching for her under her maiden name, Mary Tarpy.

Upon trying to browse the 1905 census it was found that Ancestry.com doesn't have the portion of the census for the town of Martinsburg — neither does Familysearch.org. Upon drilling down further it turned out that Familysearch didn't really have what it claimed to have. The user was redirected to Ancestry.com which Familysearch referred to as its "partner."

The 1910 census for the town of Martinsburg was browsed page by page for both districts (89 and 90) and the only Tarpys found were William and Anastasia Tarpy who were not related to Mrs. Ellen Tarpey in the above obituary. Anastasia's maiden name was Gleeson and she was born in Co. Waterford; she came to Martinsburg in 1870.

An analysis of the distribution of surnames in the Griffith's Valuation (circa 1850) showed that the majority of the Tarpy variations were found in the counties of Clare, Galway and Mayo, with a significant grouping of the Torpy variation in Co. Waterford. It is also important to recognize that Griffith's Valuation was a land-based survey and only included the hold of the household. Each of the surnames in the valuation represented a family so that actual number of individuals would be significantly larger than the number appearing in the valuation.

The area around Pompey, Onondaga County, NY was filled with recent immigrants from the central Co. Tipperary area. There was a strong chain migration effect operating in this area with many people from around the Upperchurch area of Co. Tipperary settling around Pompey.

The parish of Templeachally is located due west of Nenagh and northeast of the city of Limerick. It is just across the River Shannon from Co. Clare where there is a large number of Torpy families. Youghalarra borders Templeachally on the northeast and is also just across the River Shannon from Co. Clare. The none of the other civil parishes are close to Upperchurch. Apparently, James Tarpy did not come from around Upperchurch, so why did he land in Pompey?







The Starting Point

The information needed for the construction of the above Tarpy family tree began with the obituary of **Honora Tarpy Toussaint**. This was followed by a census search and then the discovery of several other family obituaries. It was eventually discovered that sisters **Delia** and **Mary Tarpy** married respectively brothers **Patrick** and **Michael Tarpy** — all were originally from Co. Mayo, Ireland.





While looking through the burials in the Lowville Rural Cemetery another Tarpey was found who did not fit into any of the known Tarpy families in the Lowville area.










