Introduction

This paper describes an effort to extend the histories of the Holycross area Long families back into the 1700s. The primary interest here are the Long families but any McGrath records or connections found during this research will also be kept. The source to be studied is the list of inscriptions transcribed from the Long and McGrath families' gravestones in the Old Holycross Cemetery. At least a dozen inscriptions describe persons who had been born in the 1700s and in some cases the inscriptions describe additional family connections. In many cases there were few or no family or geographic connections described in the gravestone inscriptions. However, in some instances the family connections were numerous and they could be supplemented with church and civil records. On a few occasions connections were found with other families from the Holycross area that had previously been researched.

All the inscriptions on the list display a unique number which was given to each stone by the transcriber. That number appears as the notation [XX] in the following family trees and is appended to the name of anyone described in one of the inscriptions and who is also interred there. Persons mentioned in the inscriptions, as in "erected by," do not have the number [XX] appended to their names, unless they are also buried in the plot.

The immediate goal was to construct family tree(s) for the persons described in the inscriptions on each stone. The trees were then expanded which involved working backward and forward in time using church and civil records and sometimes even census records. The various trees were then examined for any connections with the other individuals interred in this cemetery.

As the result of previous research** there were two areas of Holycross parish that were of special interest in the present research. One area is Lisnagrough and Glenreaghmore and the other area is the townland of Raheen. It was determined during the present research that the Long families of Killenyarda and Galbertstown are connected to the Long families of Lisnagrough and Glenreaghmore. The inscriptions involving persons from Raheen had the largest number of persons born in the 1700s. It was possible to make a few connections to their descendants who were known from earlier research**.

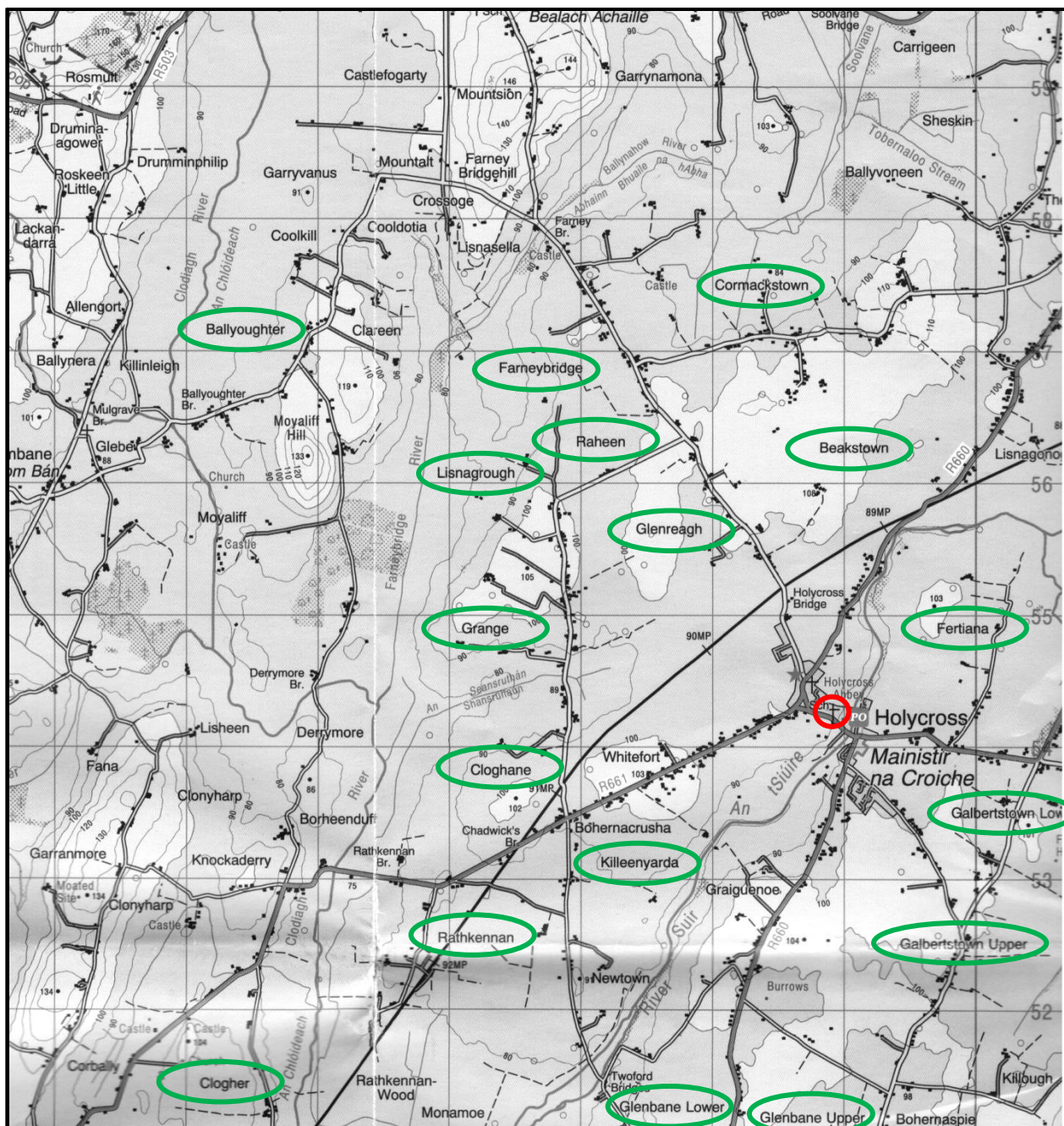

These records describe the family of Richard Long's 3rd marriage to Ellen Ryan. Richard isn't mentioned in the inscriptions from the Old Holycross Cemetery but his father Richard and brother Laurence are buried there.

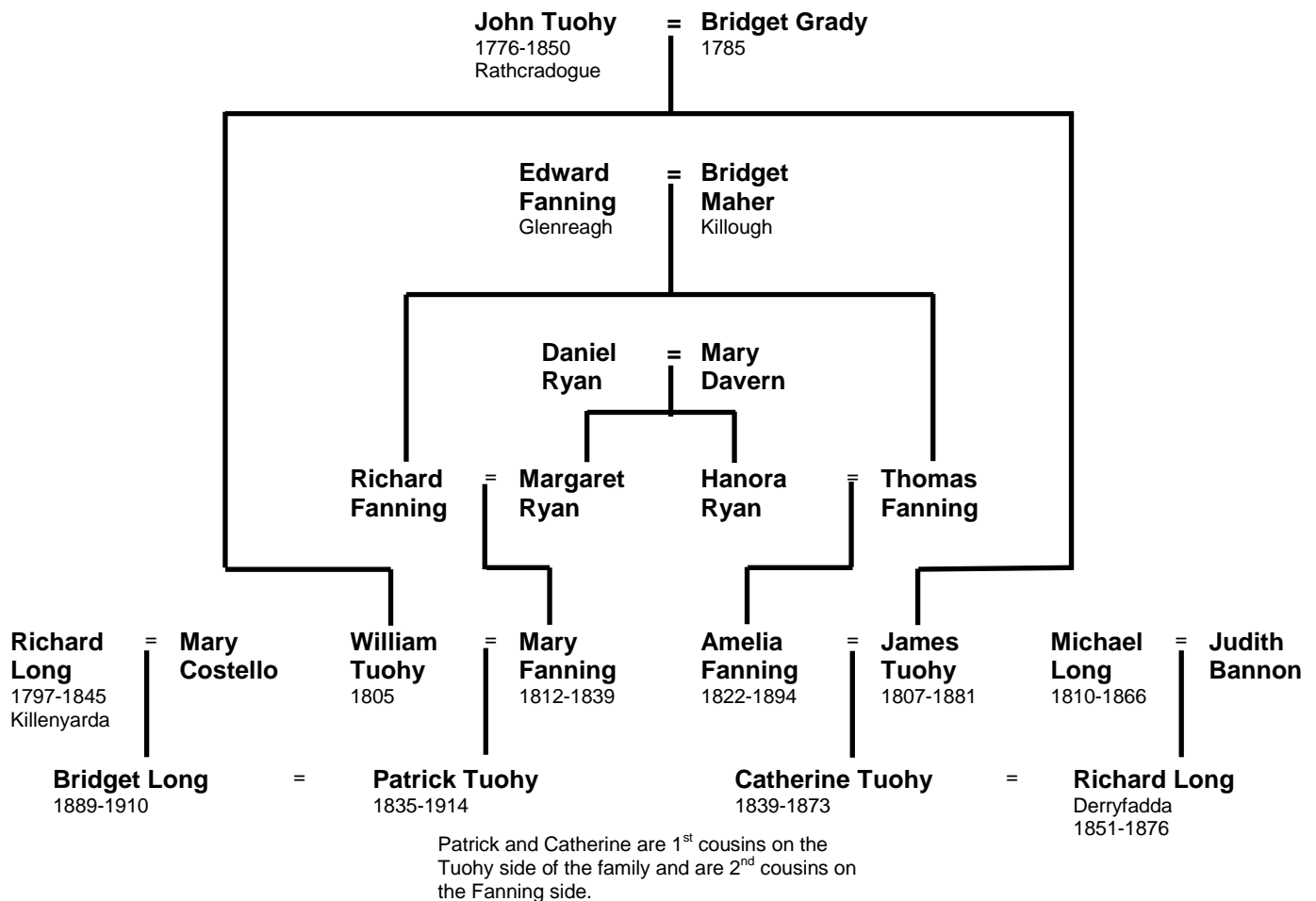

This is a very symmetrical family tree, however, to be able to display this level of symmetry it was necessary to depart from the usual practice of keeping all persons of one generation on the same line. This is the case with John Tuohy and Bridget Grady and also Edward Fanning and Bridget Maher. If the bottom line is referred to as the 1st generation then everything up to Daniel Ryan and Mary Davern, in the 4th generation, is in the proper order. Edward Fanning and Bridget Maher also belong in the 4th generation and John Tuohy and Bridget Grady are part of the 3rd generation. Whether Richard Long and Michael Long, on the extreme ends of the family tree, are related is still an open question. There was a 3rd Tuohy brother, Patrick Tuohy (1806-1873), who married Amelia's sister, Bridget Fanning (d. 1883).

It is possible that Long was Margaret's married name and her maiden name was not given in the inscription might be Ryan. Laurence Long was associated with Galbertstown at the time of his death but his residence was Lisnagrough at the time of the birth of his three youngest children.

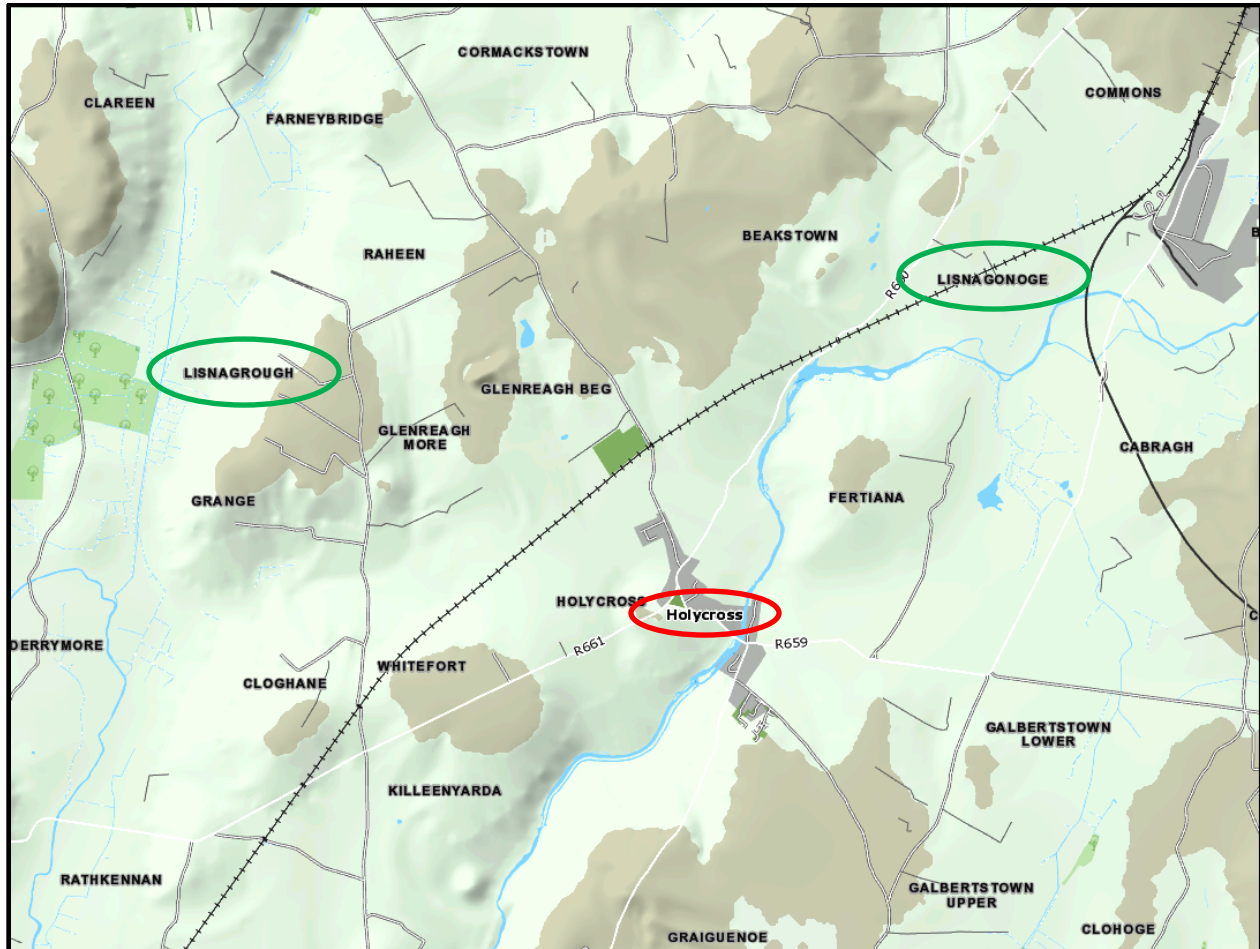

NOTE: It is assumed that the residence for Ellen Long's baptism was supposed to be Lisnagrough based on its appearance in the baptism records of her siblings Richard and Nancy. See the map on the following page for the relative location of the two townlands.

Laurence Long (Galbertstown on his headstone) is also buried near Tom Long's (of Glenreagh) family plot and was thought by Tom to be the same Laurence formerly of Lisnagrough. That Laurence had a farm adjacent to John Long and Mary Magrath. The author always felt they were related, either as John's brother or son. The proximity of their graves is another indication of a relationship.

Lisnagrough and Lisnagonoge

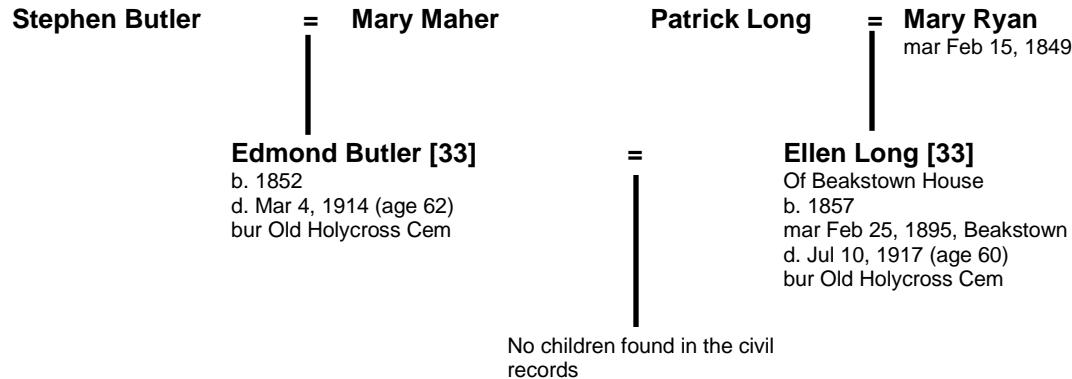


The townlands of Lisnagrough and Lisnagonoge are both located in Holycross civil parish and are on an east-west line, separated by approximately 4 km. The Old Holycross Cemetery is located in the red oval at the center of the map.

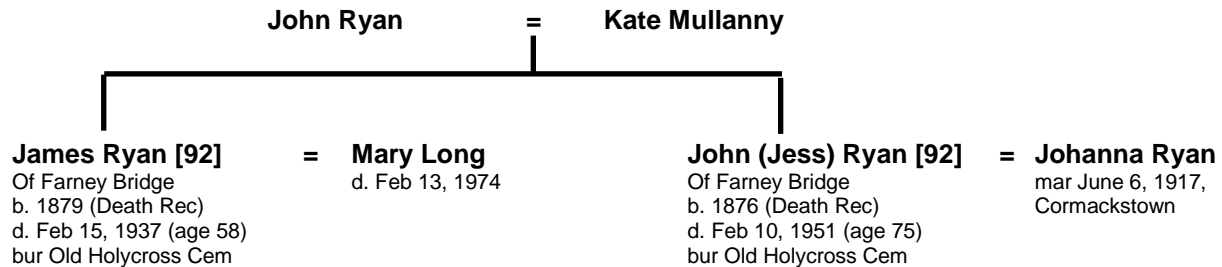

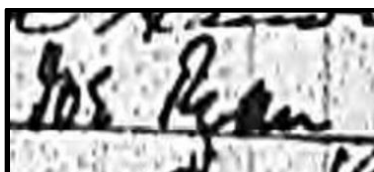

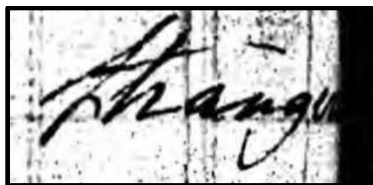

This inscription described two individuals named Long however the residence of Derryfadda is located some 15 km northeast of the Old Holycross Cemetery. The Complex Connections of Richard Long

On January 16, 1871 Richard Long (19 year old bachelor) of Derryfadda married Catherine Tuohy (31 year old spinster) of Rathcriddoge. Catherine died on March 20, 1873 and there is no record of the couple having any children. Richard Long (23 year old widower) married a second time on February 2, 1874 to Ellen Grimes (24 year old spinster). Richard and Ellen had two children: Michael (b. March 12, 1875) and Richard John (b. March 24, 1876). Richard died on January 4, 1876 at the age of 25. On July 10, 1878, Richard's widow remarried to another man also named Richard Long. This 2nd Richard Long and Ellen also had two children: James (b. October 15, 1879) and John (b. January 19, 1881). By marrying a second Richard Long and using her maiden name in the baptism records of the children she had with this 2nd Richard, she made it difficult to discover that there were two husbands named Richard Long.

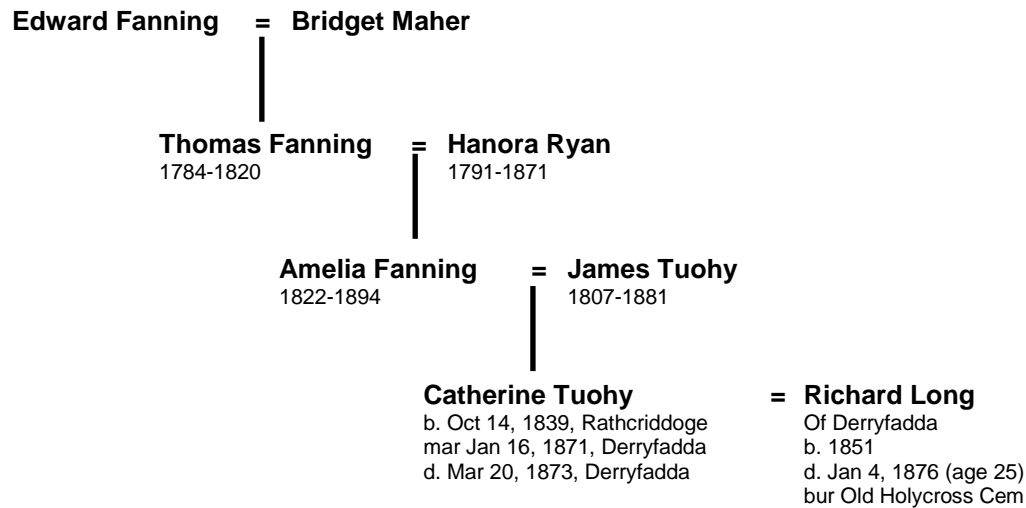

The relationship between Richard and Margaret was one of father and daughter. However, the years and ages given in the inscription aren't compatible. Margaret's age at death in 1877 was 18 years meaning that she was born in about 1859. This is a problem since it is 42 years after the death of her father. The civil records contain a Margaret Long who died in 1877 at the age of 66. There wasn't an image of the original record so Margaret's father's name is not available. This second Margaret would have been born in about 1811 which is 6 years prior to Richard Long's death. This might be the Margaret in the inscription but Richard would have been 64 years old when this Margaret was born.

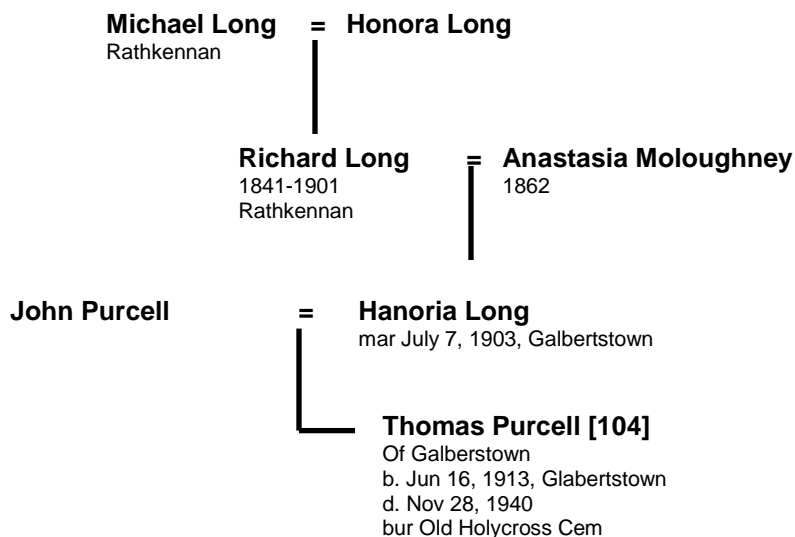

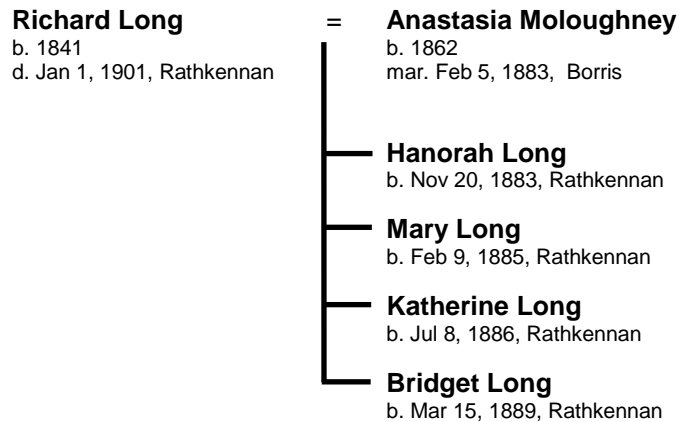

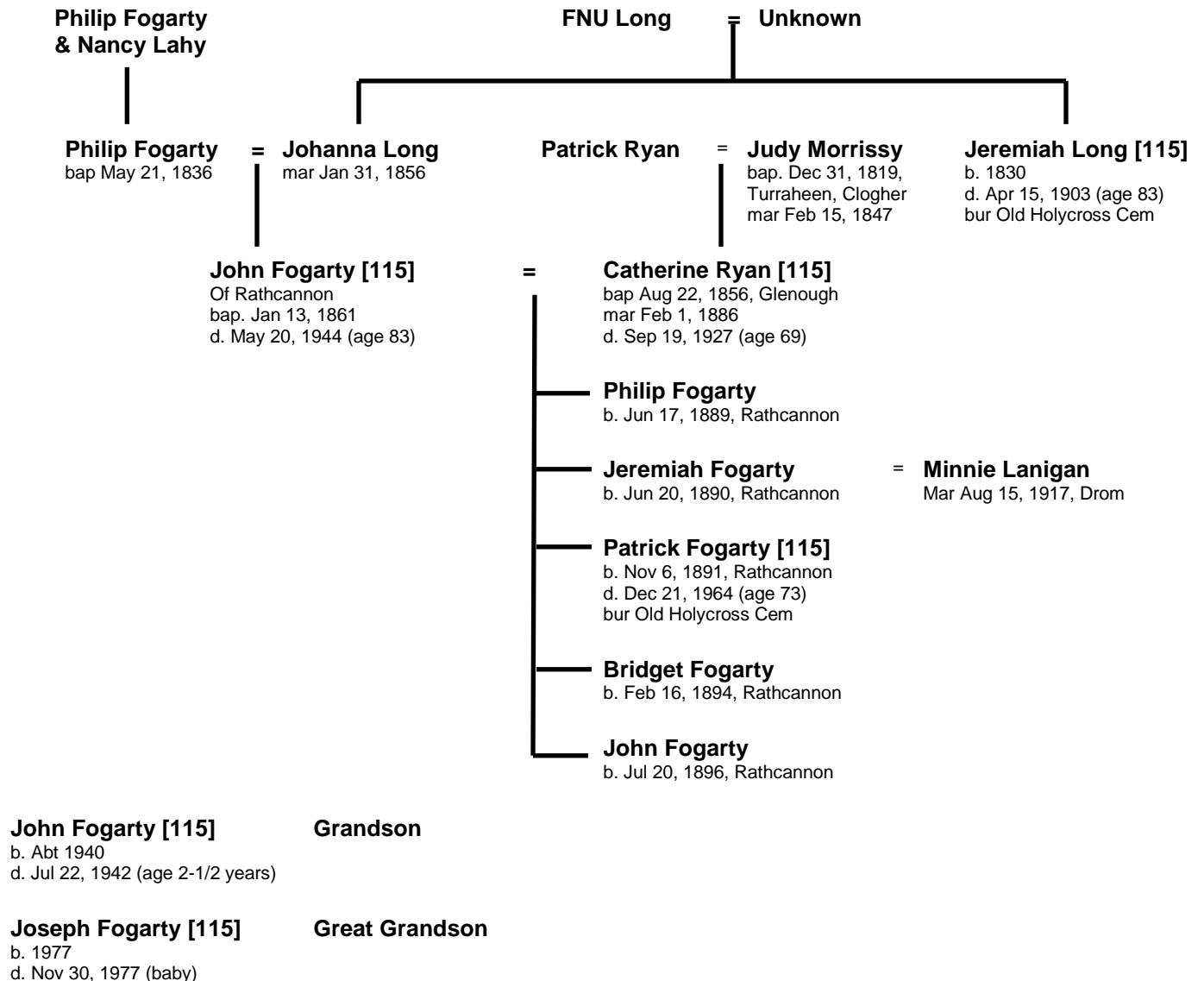

No evidence of any children for Daniel and Elizabeth were found in church records (1872-1892). These marriage records are the only items that connect Daniel Long with Drom parish and are the only evidence that his wife's last name was Corbett. Daniel Long was born in Ballycahill, was living there in 1901 and 1911 and died there in 1920. In the 1911 census it stated that he and Elizabeth had been married 40 years. A search of the Ballycahill marriage records over the period Jan 1869 to Feb 1876 turned up no record of their marriage. A reason to be married in Drom was that it was Elizabeth's home parish. However, a line by line search of the Drom and Inch RC parish records, from June 1848 to December 1852, turned up no baptism record for an Elizabeth Corbett. Although this range is expected to capture Elizabeth's birth as determined from other sources. There was no other marriage record for a Daniel Long marrying a woman named Elizabeth anywhere else in Ireland. This Drom and Inch record has Daniel's father as Michael which is verified by the Ballycahill church records.

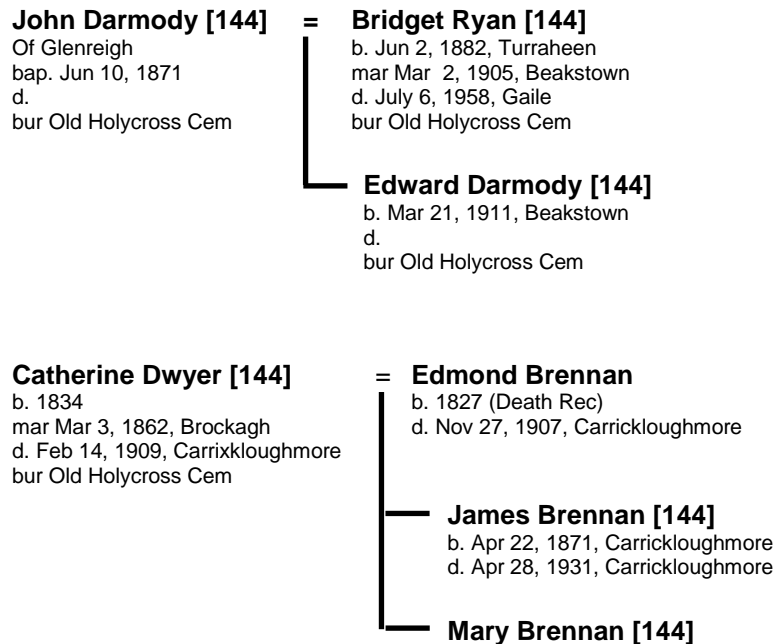

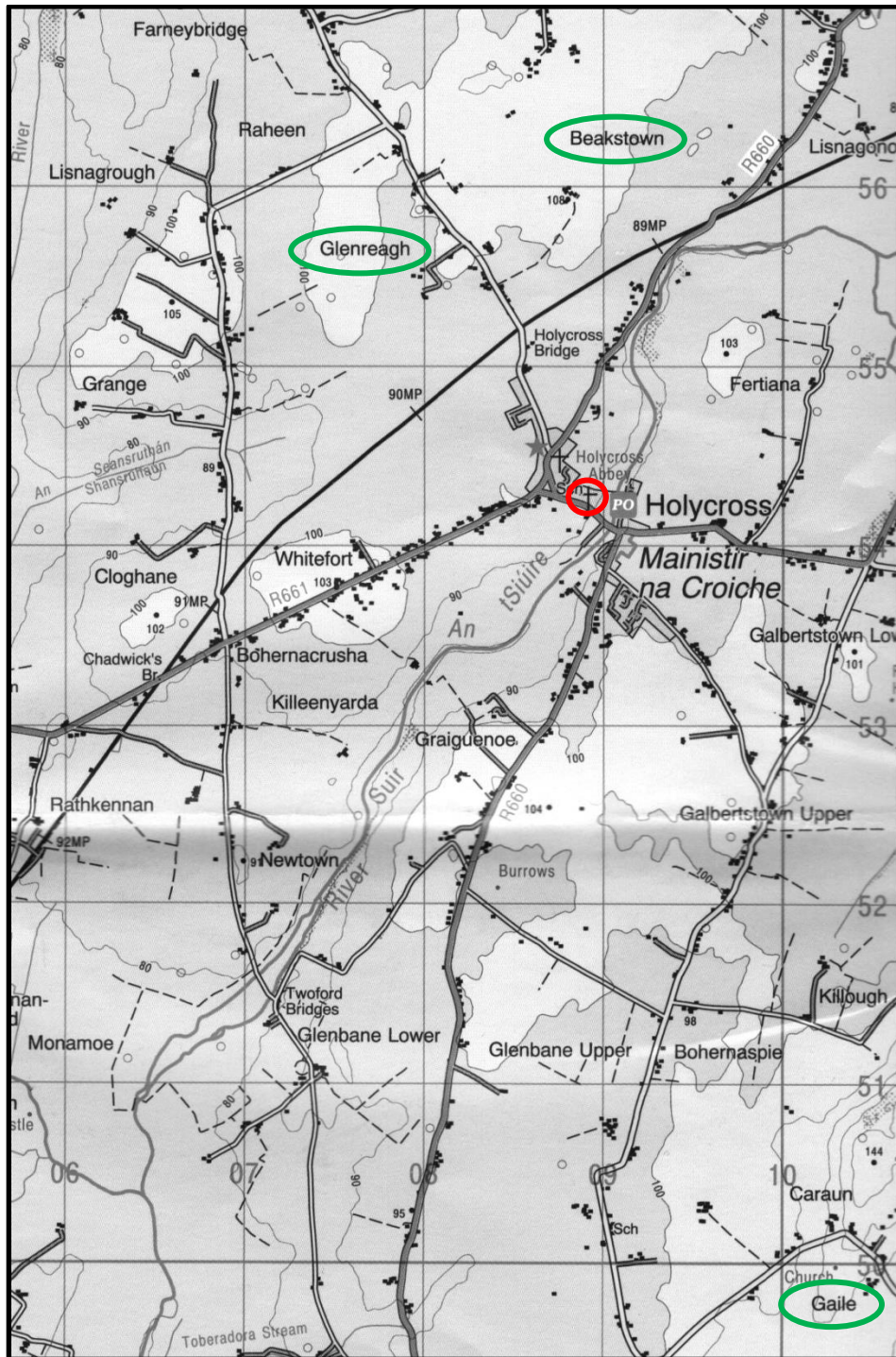

Almost all of the records associated with the Darmody family are linked to the townland of Beakstown. On his gravestone John Darmody was described as being from Glenreagh, which is the adjacent townland on the west side of Beakstown. The one death record that could be found for any member of the family was John's wife Bridget Ryan who was residing in the townland of Gaile at the time of her death in 1958. Bridget was a widow at the time of her death and the informant was her son Patrick Darmody. She might have started living with Patrick after the death of her husband.

The Brennan Problem - The Daughter Scenario

The initial lack of dates for any of the individuals buried in this plot created uncertainty as to Catherine Brennan's exact connection to this Darmody family. The first approach was to find any Brennan family in the area where the wife was named Catherine and there were at least two children, named James and Mary. Since there were no dates it was decided to start with the youngest persons as determined by their relationships. After searching both Thurles and Cashel districts, the Brennan-Carmody records below were the most closely connected individuals who could be found. The second task is to determine the nature of the Brennan family connection to the Darmody family. This wasn't a "Catherine" but it was a Darmody which could explain the connection and there was a son named James. Perhaps Mary also went by the name Catherine but then a second child named Mary was never found.

Based on Mary Darmody's age in her marriage record her birth year was about 1850. A search for a John Darmody and a wife named Bridget around the 1840-1850 time period never turned up any possible candidates. Then this Mary Darmody was dropped and it was decided to look for John and Bridget's marriage in the civil records and likely candidates were found in Beakstown in 1905. Subsequently they were found in the census and the birth records of their 11 children were found. No death record was found for John but one was eventually found for Bridget Ryan Darmody. No death records were found for their children Edward and Catherine and no record of a Brennan marriage was found. In the end the Brennan Problem was never solved.

The Brennan Problem - The Godmother Scenario

All the efforts, up to this point, to identify Catherine Brennan focused on her being the daughter of John Darmody and Bridget Ryan - those efforts were not successful. While searching for John Darmody's parents the following baptism record was found in the Clonoulty RC parish records.

Conclusion

The case for the above described Catherine Brennan, John Darmody's godmother, being the Catherine Brennan buried in the Darmody plot in the Old Holycross Cemetery, is stronger than the case for it being his daughter Catherine. A search of the parish registers in Clonoulty RC parish where John Darmody was baptized produced a marriage of Catherine Dwyer to Edward Brennan. Weddings were usually performed in the wife's parish however none of the couple's three children were baptized in Clonoulty. The Brennan family resided in Carrickloughmore, Loughmoe West parish and their children were baptized Loughmore and Castleiny RC parish. The Godmother scenario is missing a daughter named Mary. The Daughter scenario is missing marriage, baptism and death records, however, this might be due in part to their being more recent and are not readily available to the public.

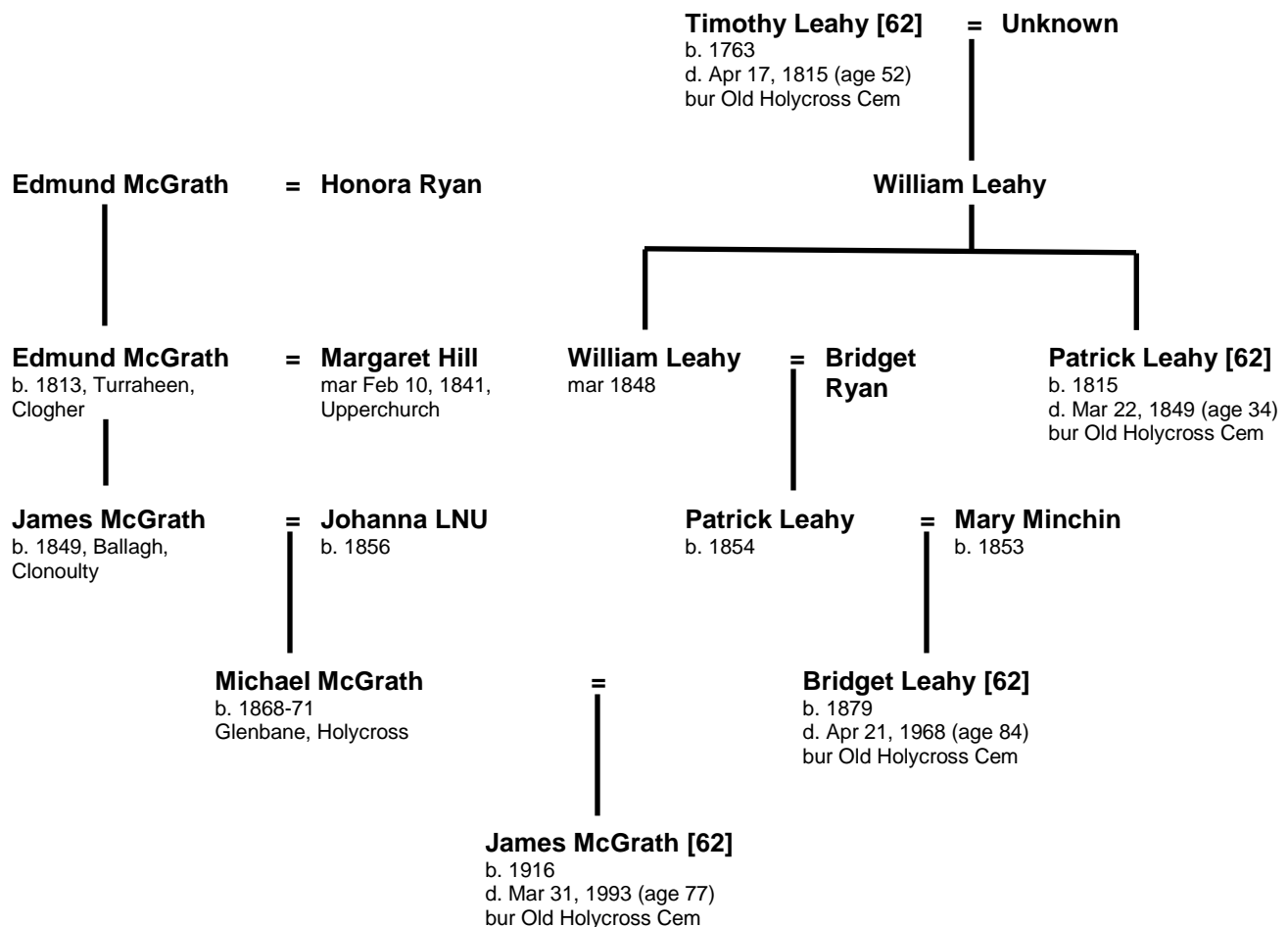

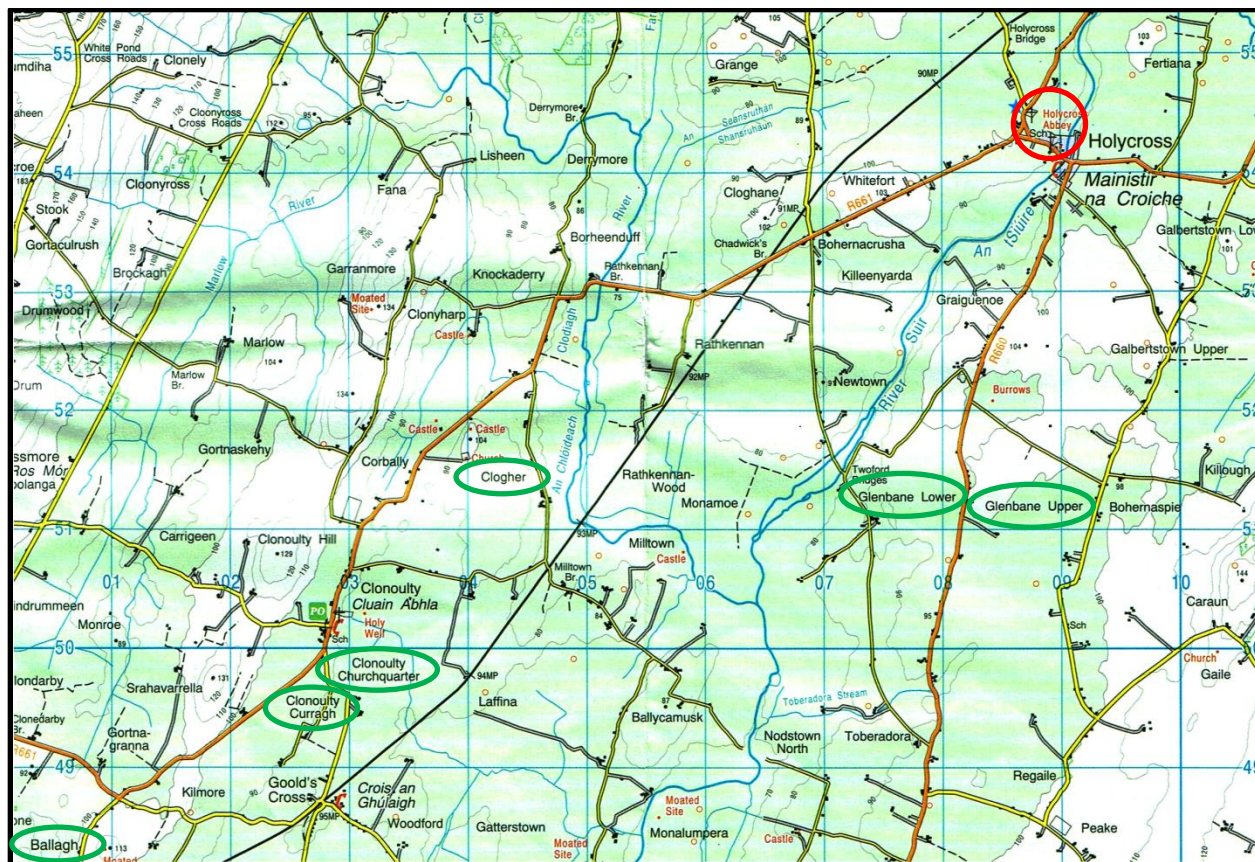
The McGrath - Leahy Family



These family connections were constructed by first finding James McGrath's (1916) birth record which gave his parent's names thus confirming Bridget Leahy as his mother and discovering his father's identity, Michael McGrath. Church and civil records were used in addition to census records to trace Bridget Leahy's connection back to Timothy Leahy (1763). Michael McGrath's family had previously been researched and they appeared in *Reconstructing Families From the Records*, pp. 66, 73-75. The details of this McGrath family have been further expanded in *Reaching Across the Penal Times*.

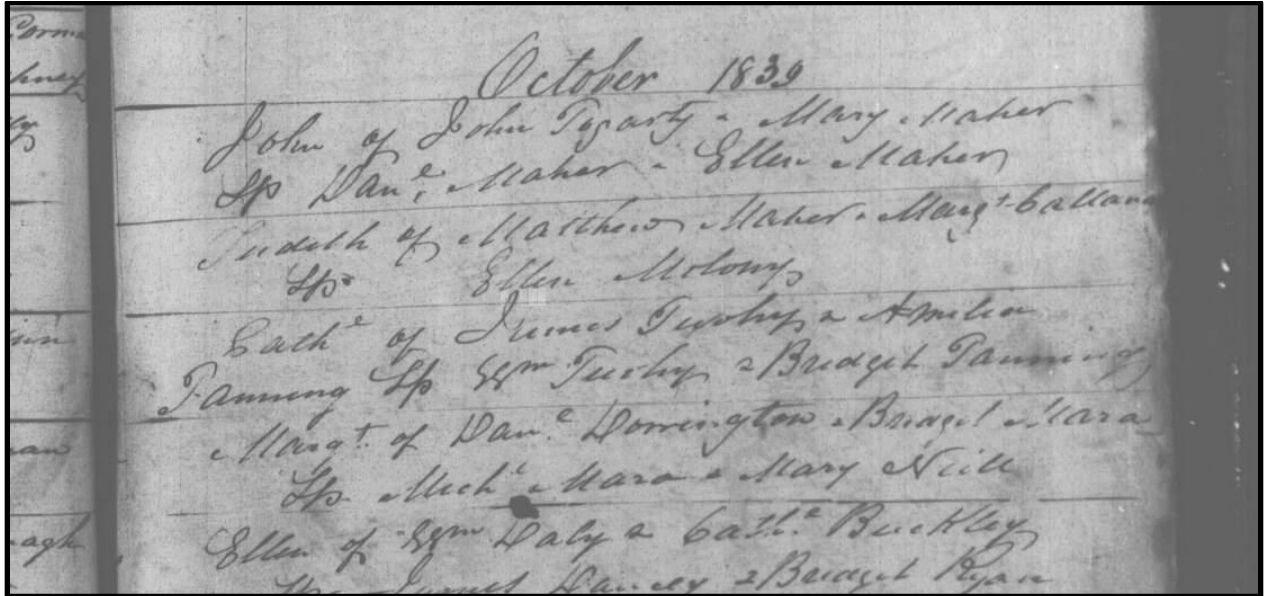

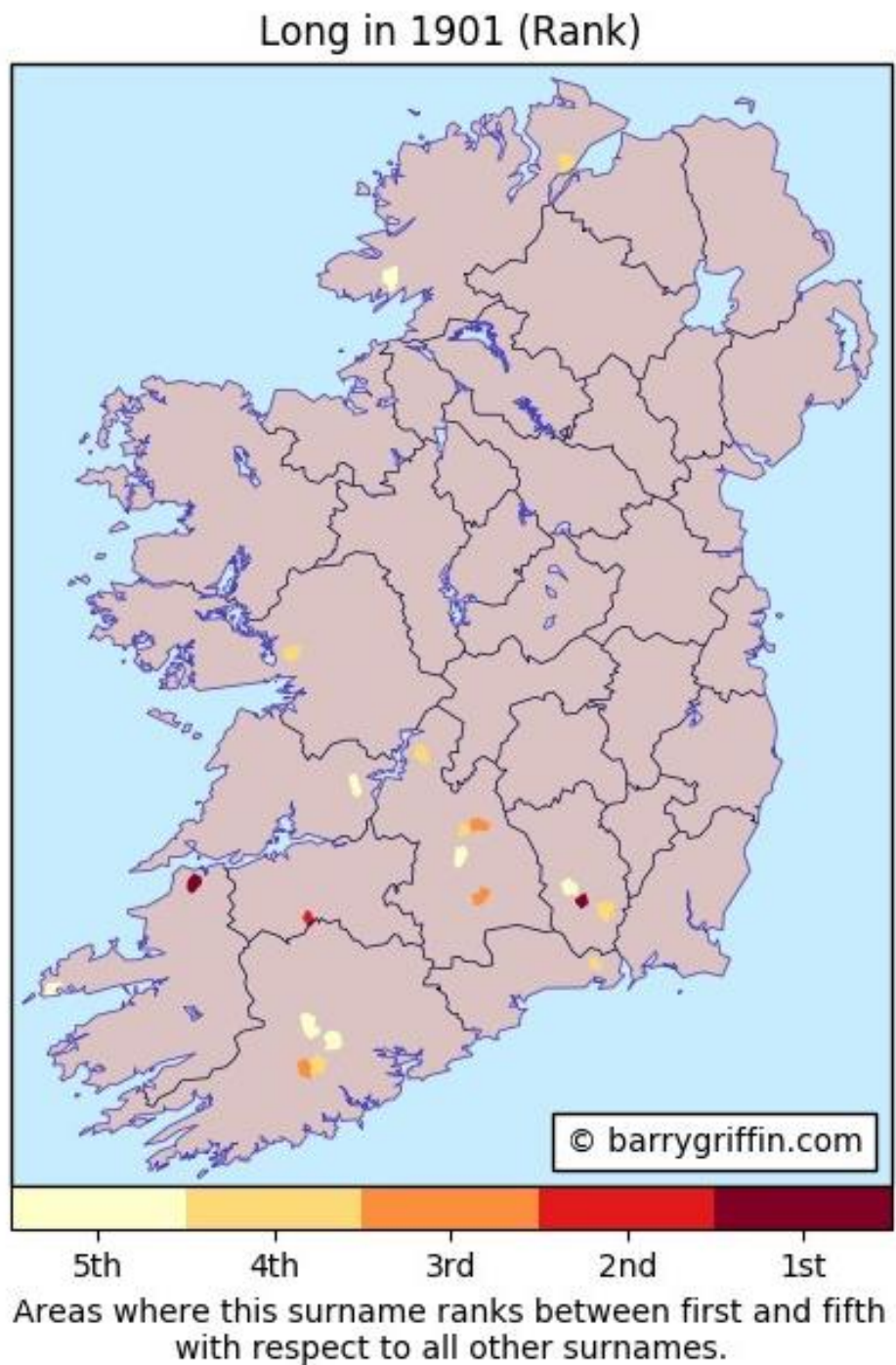

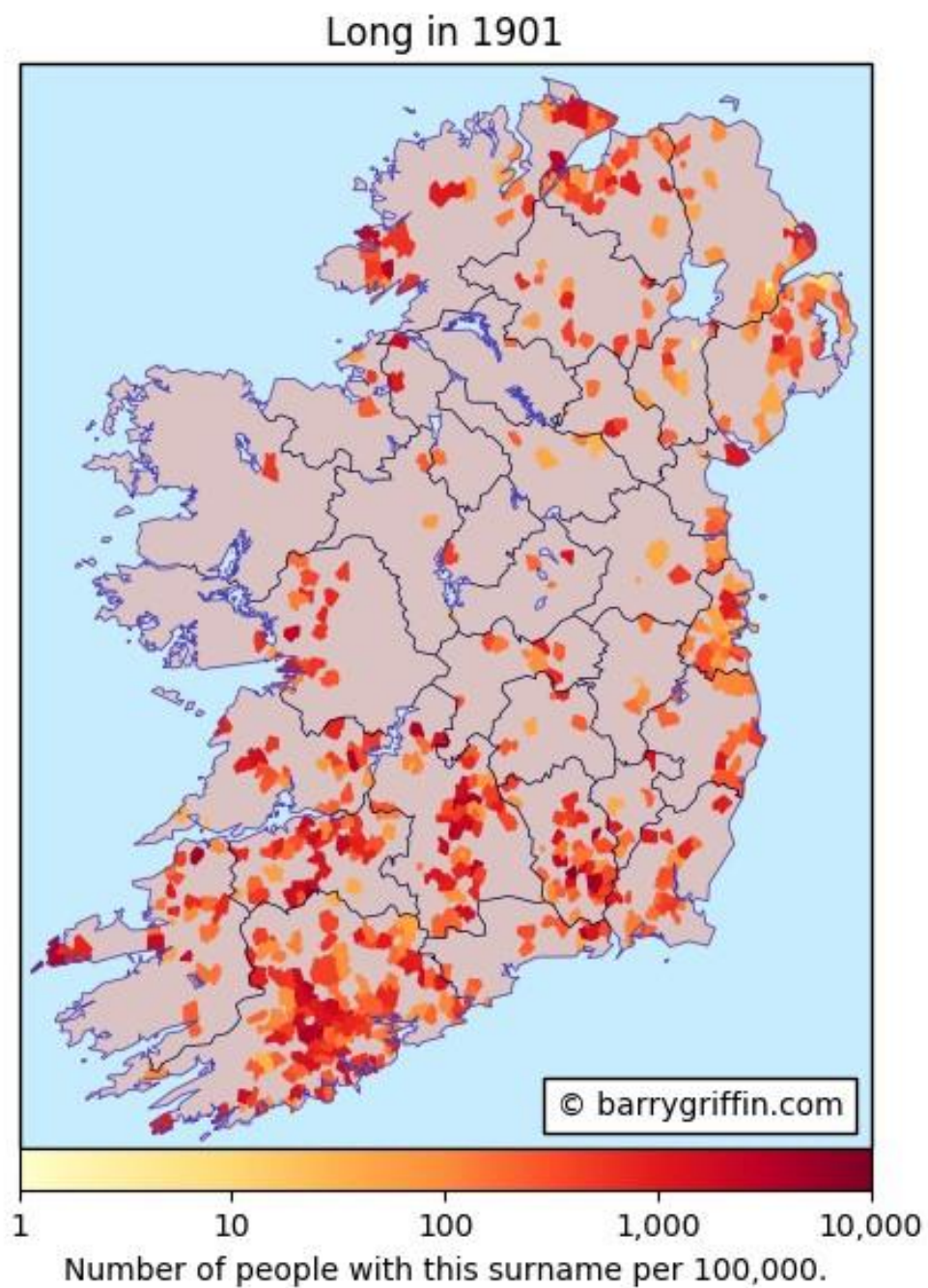


Marriage of John Grimes and Judith Dillon. Notice Judith Maher as a witness on the previous record.

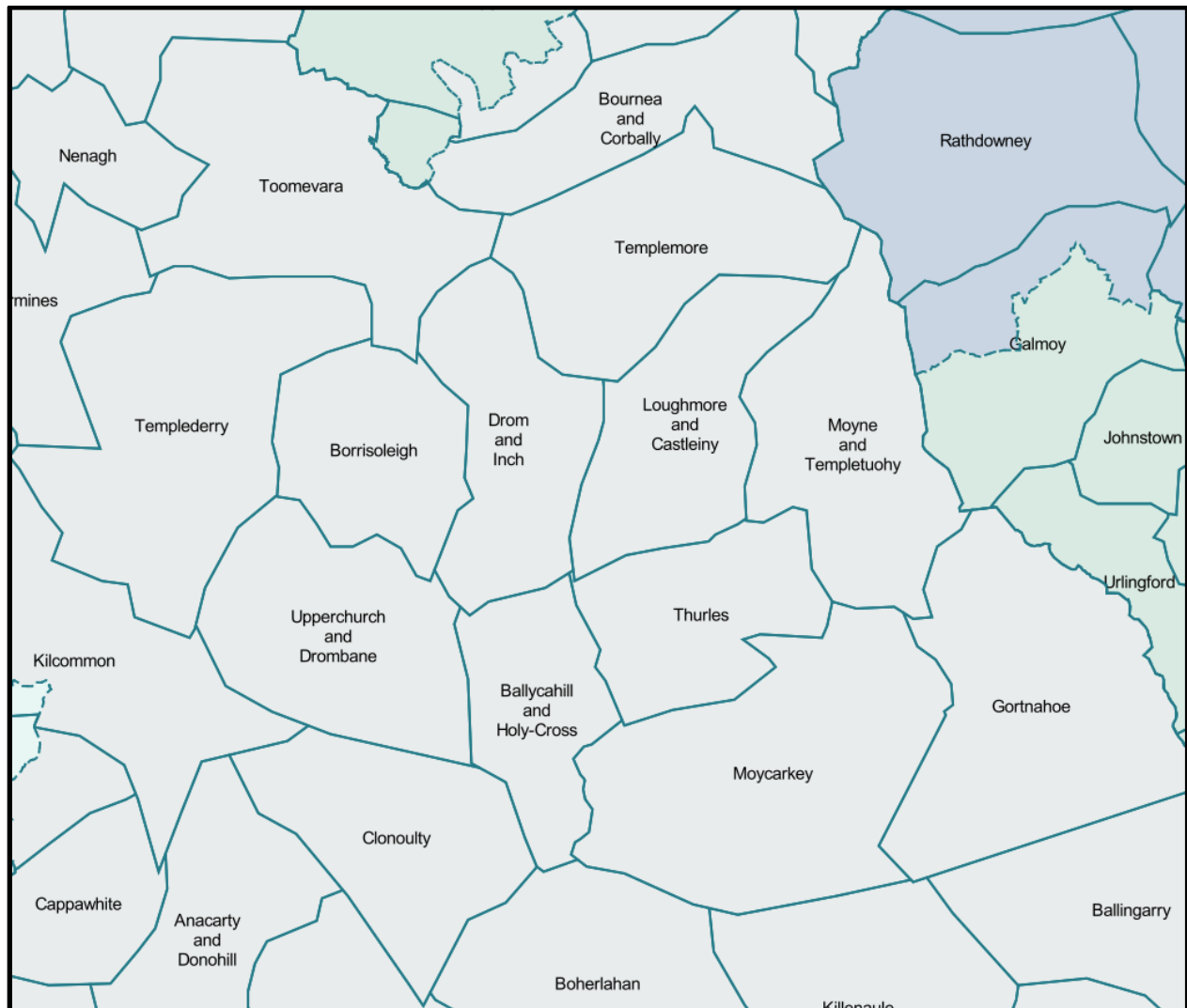
Long Surname Rankings - 1901 Census
