# MATTY'S MEMOIRS

## CHAPTER IV.

It was about this time that I began to get well acquainted with one of the strangest and most interesting characters I have ever known in Syracuse—John Simeon Dunfee.

That is, he always claimed those three names as his, although nobody ever called him anything but "Sim."

In all my experience with all kinds of men, I never met one anything like Sim Dunfee. He was the only one of his kind in the world, I guess. There couldn't have been another like him.

I don't know where he was born, but it was somewhere around this part of the country. He had no folks, apparently, because he used to tell me how he had been shifting for himself since he was old enough to walk. He shined shoes and sold newspapers and slept around in empty packing boxes or anywhere he could find shelter.

And yet, when he died, he left almost \$1,500,000—and I guess he must have spent as much more.

Sim Dunfee's first real job was what we called "driving the line" on the canal. That meant driving a team of horses or mules between stables that the bigger boat companies had established along the Erie and Oswego canals. A lot of them combined to maintain stables and animals, and working for the combination was called "driving the line." The independent boat-owners furnished their own animals and drivers and they had a tough time of it. When a "line" boat met an independent, there was always trouble.

Sim was only a young fellow, but he was tough, and he got tougher on the canal. He could hold his own with anybody, any time. I was no pink tea lad, myself, in those days, but I doubt if I could have gone through what Sim took—and threw on—while he was on the canal.

He quit, finally, to go into the business of furnishing "plugs," or cheap horses, to the independent boat-owners. They were cheap, shoddy animals, and they didn't last long at the work. Sim used to buy up stuff anywhere he could, doctor it up, and sell it to the independent boatmen at a good price. He made some money but not much.

Finally, he opened a saloon up in Burnet av., near Beech st., and got a lot of business off the canal. He kept on in the horse business, too, and gradually got into politics around the ward. From that, it was an easy step into small city contracts, like sewers and grading, and pretty soon he bobbed up as a contractor on the canal expansion.

Jim Belden, who had been a contractor, himself, took a fancy to Sim Dunfee, and it was Belden's backing that enabled Sim to get out of the plier class. Any time he wanted either money or advice, he could get what he needed from Belden. Belden got him the engineer—Taylor—who did all his figuring, and Belden put up the money for equipment or guarantees whenever Sim asked.

The job that made Sim Dunfee rich was the digging of a tunnel under the Charles River in Boston. A dozen contractors had tried it and failed when Sim put in a bid and got an order to go ahead. How he ever did it, nobody knew but Sim, Taylor and Jim Belden, but he did. He put the tunnel through and collected his profit—which was close to a million dollars.

Dunfee spent plenty of money, but he never trimmed to any extent. He knew what he wanted and was willing to pay for it. One thing about him always sticks out in my mind. Every deal Sim ever made with anybody, where there was to be a cut of profits, he would say:

"The big end goes to Sim!" And it did, too, or else Sim wouldn't go in. He always insisted on the biggest share or he wouldn't play.

I remember one time when Sim and I went up to Rochester to put up ball for a fellow named Jim Gallagher, who was in trouble—in fact, I think he had killed somebody in a fight. We went in before old Judge Rich, who lived in Auburn, and told him we wanted to sign the bonds. Sim didn't look, act or talk as if he had a nickel in his jeans.

The judge asked Sim: "What property have you got—if any?" It burned Sim up, and he yelled: "I pay taxes on property assessed at \$75,000 down in Syracuse. What more do you want?" Well, that silenced Judge Rich, but, when he had signed the papers, he looked at what was supposed to be Sim's signature and asked:

"What's this?" Sim yelled at him: "That's my name! What do you think it is?"

The judge said: "I wouldn't say it was much of anything, myself!" It wasn't either, because Sim couldn't read or write and never saw the inside of a schoolhouse in his life. When he signed something, nobody in the world could have told what the scribbling was intended to mean.

As might be expected from such a "diamond in the rough," Sim Dunfee was a mass of contradictions. He was as tough as nails and as tender-hearted as a woman. He would dive into a fight for a friend at the risk of his life, but wouldn't walk across the road to save a stranger from annihilation. He would trust certain people that nobody else would trust with anything, he said, and he wouldn't let some so-called respectable bankers hold his hat. He drank and swore and

gambled like a canaler, but he had a lot of respect for religion and never criticized the folks who practiced it.

It was Sim Dunfee who put me into the saloon business—and he did it against my own judgment. I never had any intention of doing anything but staying with the

lively business, with politics as a side line, until the end of my days, and if it hadn't been for Sim Dunfee, I would probably be right there yet.
